This Month's Message from Pastor Josh Davis

The summer months are upon us now and that means Vacation Bible School is set to kick off. This year, VBS will take place June 5th through 9th from 9:00-11:30 AM, concluding with a program for kids and parents at 11:30 am in the church sanctuary on Friday the 9th. All this is structured around the theme, "Under Construction." You'll see hard hats and orange barrels all around the building, reminding us of how we are being "built into a spiritual house" (1 Peter 2:5).

The Bible is filled with examples of important building projects. From Noah's construction of the Ark (Genesis 6:14-16), to the building of the tabernacle (Exodus 26) and the temple (1 Kings 6), to the rebuilding of the walls of Jerusalem (the book of Nehemiah) God's people have often been involved in significant construction work. And we ourselves, as people of God are constantly "under construction." We are being built into a community, gathered around and united in our Lord Jesus Christ.

As we are being built, we continue to grow:

- In number. We welcomed more than a dozen new members into our family of faith last month through the new member class. You can find their pictures and contact information in this newsletter, on a page that you can pull out and put into the back of your picture directory. We have also celebrated 12 baptisms already this year (with more to come), in which God has claimed infants, children and adults as members of the body of Christ. What a joy to see the kingdom of God expanding among us!
- In knowledge. We are never too young or too old to continue learning more

about our great and gracious God. This summer, there are opportunities for all ages during the Education Hour on Sunday morning (9:15-10:15). Preschool - 6th graders are invited (parents too!) to learn about the Fruits of the Spirit through Bible lessons, singing, craft and fruit tasting. 7th through 12th graders will be watching Bible story videos and comparing them to the text of Scripture. And adults are invited to join in a weekly study, also learning about the Fruits of the Spirit, beginning on June 11th.

-In our love for others. Members of our congregation will be taking part in mission trips to Puerto Rico (June 10th-17th), Omaha, Nebraska (July 9th – 14th) and South Dakota (July 23rd – July 28th) to serve others and model Christ's love. We've all had the opportunity to support these teams (and other servants of God) through our time, donations, and prayers, and we will send them off with a blessing in worship on the Sundays before they depart.

God is at work in our lives and in our family of faith as the master builder, constructing us into a spiritual house. As you know, any good building project must begin with a solid foundation, and so as we are under construction, we can take heart that we are "built on the rock" - the solid foundation of Christ Jesus, our cornerstone (Ephesians 2:19-20). "In Him, the whole building is joined together and rises to become a holy temple in the Lord. In Him, you too are being built together to become a dwelling place for God by His Spirit" (Ephesians 2:21-22). Come, join us this summer to be under construction, built upon Christ.


