#### This Month's Message from Pastor Josh Davis

August is upon us once again, and that means the beginning of a new week-day school year here at Faith Lutheran. We'll kick things off as we have in past years with a Fall Jamboree on the evening of August 23rd. You're invited to join us for a pulled pork and hot dog dinner from 5:30-6:25 pm (no need to bring anything — just come and eat). At 6:30, we'll all gather in the sanctuary for an opening devotion, introducing our theme for the year. After the opening, everyone will be dismissed to their classrooms for a brief introduction to their teachers and classes. Then at 7:30, we'll end the evening with an ice cream social on the east lawn. Weekday school classes are offered for adults and children ages 3 and up. They will continue on Wednesday evenings from 6:30 to 7:30 pm until we break for the season of Advent.

Our theme for this year is "Connected." As part of God's family of faith, we have been connected to our Lord in baptism, when we were marked with God's own Triune name ("in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit"). St. Paul says that through our baptism, we are connected with Jesus in His death and in His resurrection (Romans 6:3-4). We are also connected with one another as the body of Christ; when one part suffers, we all do; when one part rejoices, we all rejoice with them (1 Corinthians 12:26).

The apostle Paul, in his letter to the Colossians states, "Christ is before all things and in Him all things hold together" (1:17). Each one of us is "connected" through Jesus, our Savior. It is His work on the cross and His defeat of death that has united us as the people of God. And it is that truth that will direct us this educational year as we study God's Word together.

This might also be a good time to revisit the significance of our congregational logo that you see used in videos, newsletters, Take-Home pages, and other publications. As part of this image (printed above for you to examine), you'll notice the shape of our church building formed by the figures of gathered people, hands lifted and stretched out in varying poses. At the top of it all is the shape of the cross, reminding us that we are held together in Jesus and by His gracious, loving sacrifice. The blue swoosh that surrounds the people recalls the baptismal water through which we joined the family of God. And on the far right and left edges of the image, we see arms reaching out — reaching out to others with the desire that they too would be connected to Jesus and His incredible grace. What a great visual reminder of how we are
