## Midweek School Parking Lot Attendants

Thanks for agreeing to serve as a parking lot attendant on Wednesday evenings. I continue to receive lots of positive feedback on how great it has been to have people out there. You are appreciated! And with the expanded parking lot this year, your job has become even more important.

By way of review (or for those of you who are new to the job this year), our main purposes for having attendants are as follows:

### **1. Safety**

With 140 kids attending midweek classes here, there are LOTS of parents, children and cars in the parking lot from 6:15 – 7:45. Occasionally, there can be issues that arise. A parking lot attendant can help direct the flow of traffic, make sure cars are not parked in a way that blocks other cars, ensure that vehicles are headed the right direction, and make sure children are not running out into danger.

### **2. A Friendly Face**

You are the first line of interaction that parents and children have with Faith Lutheran Church. A smile, handshake, high-five, or simple “Hello” can go a long way towards making people of all ages feel welcome here. In some cases, you may be the only member of Faith Lutheran that parents come into contact with.

### **3. Direction**

Each parking lot attendant vest will have a map in the pocket which explains what classes will be held in which rooms. If you come across a child or adult who is lost or confused about where they should be, you can guide them to the appropriate place.

Midweek classes begin on August 22<sup>nd</sup>. Parking lot attendants should be outside ready to go by 6:10 (before people begin showing up). Traffic should let up by 6:45, but please be outside again ready to go at 7:10, when many parents will begin returning to pick up their children. Your evening should be complete when all the midweek students are headed home, around 7:45. (The high school XYF Youth will still be meeting inside, but you don’t need to worry about them.) You may pick up your vests and “Stop/Slow” signs in the sacristy before you begin and return them there at the end of the night.
