# ***INTRODUCTION AND PREFACE***

**Hello, I am Ryan Tatham. My wife and I have the honor and privilege of pastoring a world-impacting church in Columbia, Tennessee. I have a passion for the Church of Jesus to walk out their God-given mission in the God-given power of the Holy Spirit. I want to see Jesus' church operating in all that Jesus has for us when we are gathered and when we are outside the walls of our buildings.**

**I am so excited that you decided to go on this 21-Day Journey to personal revival. I truly believe that you will grow closer to Jesus through this process. You will have a fresh fire from the Holy Spirit in you at the end of these 21 days.**

**This devotional is a very simple template; each day you are going to surrender to Jesus something different in your lives. You are going to look at scripture that reinforces the surrender statement. Then you will pray a simple prayer that reinforces the surrender statement. Use the prayer written until you feel comfortable enough to make it your own. Please note that the goal is to help you make these prayers your own. Then there will be an action step on how to put into action the surrender statement.**

**As you go through these days of this devotional, the Holy Spirit might give you a specific action step to take for your life. Write it down and do it.**

**My heart is that this devotional will open your ears and eyes to see what the Holy Spirit is doing and where He is leading as you surrender to Jesus.**

# Give Jesus your **LIFE**

## **SCRIPTURE**

“25For God presented Jesus as the sacrifice for sin. People are made right with God when they believe that Jesus sacrificed his life, shedding his blood. This sacrifice shows that God was being fair when he held back and did not punish those who sinned in times past, 26for he was looking ahead and including them in what he would do in this present time. God did this to demonstrate his righteousness, for he himself is fair and just, and he makes sinners right in his sight when they believe in Jesus.”

Romans 3: 25-26 NLT

## **PRAYER**

**Lord Jesus, I thank you that you are enough for me. I dedicate my life to you, realizing that this world has nothing for me. I believe you are the Son of God and that you died in my place for my sins on the cross. I believe that three days later you were raised to life. I ask, Lord Jesus, that you forgive me of all my sins and cleanse me from all unrighteousness. I invite you to be the Savior and Lord of my life. I choose this day to give you my life and to live for you.**

## **ACTION STEP**

- If you prayed that for the first time, YAY! Welcome to the family. I would encourage you to speak to your local pastor because you need to be baptized as commanded by Jesus.
- If you prayed this for the first time or as a prayer of rededication to Jesus, I would encourage you to plug into a local body of believers where you can be discipled and grow in your relationship with Jesus.
- A great first step is to keep talking to Jesus through prayer and to open the Bible. If you don't have a Bible, you can visit Bible.com or scan the QR code to the right.
- Also, keep going with this simple devotional.

# Give Jesus your **LOVE**

## **SCRIPTURE**

"We love Him ( Jesus ), because He ( Jesus ) first loved us"

1 John 4:19

"37Jesus replied, "'You must love the Lord your God with all your heart, all your soul, and all your mind.' 38This is the first and greatest commandment. 39A second is equally important: 'Love your neighbor as yourself.' 40The entire law and all the demands of the prophets are based on these two commandments."

Matthew 22: 37-40

## **PRAYER**

**Father, I choose to love you first and most. Help me to surrender all my affection to you first. Father, as I love you with all of me, let your love flow through me to those around me so they might experience your love as I have. I ask this all in the powerful name of Jesus. Amen.**

## **ACTION STEP**

- Keep this simple, verbally tell Jesus you love.
- Intentionally do things that would bring Jesus joy.
- Do something intentional to bless a neighbor.
- Also keep going in this simple devotional

# Give Jesus your **REPENTANCE**

## **SCRIPTURE**

“Prove by the way you live that you have repented of your sins and turned to God.” Matthew 3:8

“Peter replied, “Each of you must repent of your sins and turn to God, and be baptized in the name of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of your sins. Then you will receive the gift of the Holy Spirit.” Acts 2:38 NLT

“Now repent of your sins and turn to God, so that your sins may be wiped away.” Acts 3:19

## **PRAYER**

**Father, I choose to go in a new direction with You leading me in this life. I want my life to reflect what Jesus has done in me, so I choose to live a life of repentance so that the Holy Spirit will be able to use me for Your kingdom. Let my life produce the fruit of the Holy Spirit. I ask all this in Jesus' mighty name, amen.**

## **ACTION STEP**

- If you sin, go quickly to Jesus and ask for forgiveness. He's not mad at you; you didn't let Him down (you weren't holding Him up). Just simply go to Him, repent, and follow Him.
- You aren't who you were before Jesus, so keep rejoicing, but you aren't yet who Jesus is making you to be, so keep repenting.
- Also, keep going in this simple devotional.



# Give Jesus your **PRAYERS**

## **SCRIPTURE**

- 'Always be joyful. Never stop praying. Be thankful in all circumstances, for this is God's will for you who belong to Christ Jesus. ' 1 Thessalonians 5:16-18
- 'Don't worry about anything; instead, pray about everything. Tell God what you need, and thank him for all he has done. Then you will experience God's peace, which exceeds anything we can understand. His peace will guard your hearts and minds as you live in Christ Jesus. '  
Philippians 4:6-7

## **PRAAYER**

**Father, I choose to use my prayers as Jesus did, to identify with you, to thank you, to worship you, to trust you, and to receive from you. I choose to make you the center of my prayer life, not myself. I thank you that you care for my needs and that you supply them. I choose to trust you by bringing them to you in prayer. May your name be praised forever in Jesus' powerful name. Amen.**

## **ACTION STEP**

- Use the Lord's prayer as a template for prayer.
  - Pray your God given identity
  - Pray with gratitude to our Father
  - Pray worship and praise
  - Pray surrender to our Father
  - Pray for your needs
  - Confess your sins to our Father
  - Pray for Help
- Also keep going in this simple devotional

# Give Jesus your **MARRIAGE**

## **SCRIPTURE**

“21And further, submit to one another out of reverence for Christ. 22For wives, this means submit to your husbands as to the Lord. 23For a husband is the head of his wife as Christ is the head of the church. He is the Savior of his body, the church. 24As the church submits to Christ, so you wives should submit to your husbands in everything. 25For husbands, this means love your wives, just as Christ loved the church. He gave up his life for her 26to make her holy and clean, washed by the cleansing of God’s word” Ephesians 5: 21-26

## **PRAYER**

**Father, I recognize the importance of marriage. You chose to use it to represent the relationship between Jesus and the Church. Forgive me if I have not taken this covenant relationship seriously enough. I choose to worship You in my marriage by honoring my spouse and serving them as You serve the Church. Father, help me put my spouse before myself. Help me walk in humility and grace. In Jesus’ mighty name, amen.**

## **ACTION STEP**

- Be intentional about serving your spouse.
- Pray together everyday, keep it simple, short, and intentional.
  - If you miss a day don’t make it two.
- Surprise your spouse with a fun activity you both will enjoy.
- Also keep going in this simple devotional

# Give Jesus your ***FUTURE***

## ***SCRIPTURE***

- 'For I know the plans I have for you,' says the Lord . "They are plans for good and not for disaster, to give you a future and a hope. In those days when you pray, I will listen. If you look for me wholeheartedly, you will find me. ' Jeremiah 29:11-13
- 'For we are God's masterpiece. He has created us anew in Christ Jesus, so we can do the good things he planned for us long ago. ' Ephesians 2:10
- 'The thief's purpose is to steal and kill and destroy. My purpose is to give them a rich and satisfying life. ' John 10:10

## ***PRAYER***

**Father, you know all things; you have numbered my days, so I trust you. I recognize that my life in your hands is secure, while my life in my hands is shaky at best. So I choose to submit my future to you and trust your plans for my life. Forgive me for trying to be the author of my story when you have a better one written for me already. I will rest in your plans and worship you, in Jesus' powerful name, Amen.**

## ***ACTION STEP***

- When you feel anxious about your future stop and remember that God is in control.
- Commit to memory scriptures that reference how God has planned your future. Know them, believe them, rest in them.
- Also keep going in this simple devotional



# Give Jesus your **CHILDREN**

## **SCRIPTURE**

- 'But Jesus said, "Let the children come to me. Don't stop them! For the Kingdom of Heaven belongs to those who are like these children." ' Matthew 19:14
- 'Children are a gift from the Lord ; they are a reward from him.' Psalms 127:3
- 'Direct your children onto the right path, and when they are older, they will not leave it. ' Proverbs 22:6
- 'Fathers, do not provoke your children to anger by the way you treat them. Rather, bring them up with the discipline and instruction that comes from the Lord. ' Ephesians 6: 4

## **PRAYER**

**Father, thank you for modeling what being a good parent is. Thank you for allowing me to have these beautiful gifts I call my children.**

**I choose this day to trust you with their futures. I will not worry about them because you love them more than I do. Instead, I will decide this day to direct them to trust in you all the days of their lives. I ask in Jesus' name that you develop in them a hunger to pursue you all the days of their lives and that I shepherd them to that end. I ask all this in Jesus' powerful name. Amen**

## **ACTION STEP**

- Be intentional to pray over your children, pray with them, for them and in front of them.
- Go out of your way to invest your time in them that builds them and you together.
- Get them involved with other kids their age at church.
- Also keep going in this simple devotional

# Give Jesus your **FAMILY**

## **SCRIPTURE**

'Love is patient and kind. Love is not jealous or boastful or proud or rude. It does not demand its own way. It is not irritable, and it keeps no record of being wronged. It does not rejoice about injustice but rejoices whenever the truth wins out. Love never gives up, never loses faith, is always hopeful, and endures through every circumstance. ' 1 Corinthians 13:4-7

## **PRAYER**

**Father, thank you for showing me what family looks like in your church. Father, I lift my earthly family before you; you know exactly what each of them needs before I even ask, whether it be salvation, healing, or provision. Father, you are enough for it all. I pray that you will give them ears to hear and eyes to see your grace and mercy and to receive from you what they need. I ask all this in Jesus' powerful name. Amen**

## **ACTION STEP**

- If there is a grievance in your relationship, choose to forgive them day in and day out.
- Pray regularly for them.
- Send them an encouragement or scripture.
- Also keep going in this simple devotional

# Give Jesus your **HURTS**

## **SCRIPTURE**

'The Lord is close to the brokenhearted; he rescues those whose spirits are crushed. The righteous person faces many troubles, but the Lord comes to the rescue each time. '

Psalms 34:18-19

'Instead, be kind to each other, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, just as God through Christ has forgiven you.'

Ephesians 4:32

'Make allowance for each other's faults, and forgive anyone who offends you. Remember, the Lord forgave you, so you must forgive others. ' Colossians 3:13

## **PRAYER**

**FATHER, THANK YOU SO MUCH FOR NEVER LEAVING ME IN THE MIDST OF EVERY HURT AND SEASON. LORD, YOU SEE EXACTLY WHAT I HAVE BEEN THROUGH, AND I CAN'T CARRY THIS ANY FURTHER. I DECIDE THIS DAY TO SURRENDER THESE HURTS TO YOU. I CHOOSE THIS DAY TO RELEASE MYSELF FROM UNFORGIVENESS AND BITTERNESS BY FORGIVING EVERY PERSON WHO HAS HURT ME. JESUS, YOU FORGAVE ME OF SO MUCH; I CHOOSE TO FORGIVE AND EXPERIENCE YOUR FREEDOM. IN YOUR NAME, JESUS, AMEN.**

## **ACTION STEP**

- If you think about it, pray about it.
  - Decide day in and day out to let Jesus help you in this.
- Don't give a voice to the hurt, it will hold you captive and make a case for you to stay hurt and unhealed
  - Redirect any thought that doesn't point you to Jesus and forgiveness to the feet of Jesus in Jesus name
- Talk to a counselor, pastor, christian friend.
- Also keep going in this simple devotional

# Give Jesus your **THOUGHTS**

## **SCRIPTURE**

“3We are human, but we don’t wage war as humans do. 4We use God’s mighty weapons, not worldly weapons, to knock down the strongholds of human reasoning and to destroy false arguments.

5We destroy every proud obstacle that keeps people from knowing God. We capture their rebellious thoughts and teach them to obey Christ.” 2 Corinthians 10: 3-5

“2Don’t copy the behavior and customs of this world, but let God transform you into a new person by changing the way you think. Then you will learn to know God’s will for you, which is good and pleasing and perfect.” Romans 12: 2

## **PRAYER**

**Father, I don’t want any thought that is not from You. I know the thoughts You have toward me are good. In the name of Jesus, I rebuke and bind any thought that is not from the Holy Spirit. I command my thoughts to agree with Jesus’ word, and I cast out all thoughts that do not. I choose this day to allow the Holy Spirit to renew my mind through God’s word, and I will fix my thoughts on Jesus. In Jesus’ powerful name, Amen.**

## **ACTION STEP**

- Before your feet hit the ground, surrender your thoughts and actions for that day to Jesus.
- When you have invasive thoughts don’t dwell on them, deal with them right where your at with prayer and scripture.
- Talk with a godly and trusted friend so they can help you.
- Also keep going in this simple devotional

# Give Jesus your **TONGUE**

## **SCRIPTURE**

“29 Don’t use foul or abusive language. Let everything you say be good and helpful, so that your words will be an encouragement to those who hear them.” Ephesians 4: 29

“20Wise words satisfy like a good meal;  
the right words bring satisfaction.

21The tongue can bring death or life;  
those who love to talk will reap the consequences.”  
Proverbs 18: 20-21

## **PRAYER**

**Father, I surrender my tongue to you. I want to say what you would have me say. I want to be an encouragement to those around me and to myself. I choose to use my tongue to declare your faithfulness, goodness, praises, and the gospel. Let my speech be filled with life and the hope found in you, Jesus. I choose to speak the life found in Jesus over my life, my family, and my friends. All to your glory and in your name, Jesus. Amen.**

## **ACTION STEP**

- Declare the promises of God over yourself.
- Declare your new identity in Jesus over yourself.
- Give out compliments like candy at a parade.
- Choose to speak life over yourself, children, spouse, church, etc.
- Also keep going in this simple devotional

# Give Jesus your **TIME**

## **SCRIPTURE**

“15 So be careful how you live. Don’t live like fools, but like those who are wise. 16 Redeem your time in these evil days. 17 Don’t act thoughtlessly, but understand what the Lord wants you to do.”  
Ephesians 5: 15-17

## **PRAYER**

**Father, I choose to make time for you. I want and am willing to redeem the time you’ve given me so my life will bring you glory. Father, help me manage my time so I don’t waste my life on what doesn’t matter, and forgive me where I have. I pray this in the powerful name of Jesus, amen.**

## **ACTION STEP**

- Start small and grow, take 5 minutes a day and pray and have devotion time with Jesus every morning.
- Spend time with fellow Christians whether it be coffee, lunch, or an activity.
- Join a life group at your local church.
- Also keep going in this simple devotional

# Give Jesus your **MONEY**

## **SCRIPTURE**

“7You must each decide in your heart how much to give. And don’t give reluctantly or in response to pressure. “For God loves a person who gives cheerfully.” 8And God will generously provide all you need. Then you will always have everything you need and plenty left over to share with others.” 2 Corinthians 9: 7-8

24 “No one can serve two masters. For you will hate one and love the other; you will be devoted to one and despise the other. You cannot serve God and be enslaved to money.”

## **PRAYER**

**Father, all that I have is yours. I choose you over anything this world has to offer. - Ask Jesus if there is anyone you should be a blessing to, then obey and give what He says cheerfully.
- Also keep going in this simple devotional

# Give Jesus your **TRUST**

## **SCRIPTURE**

“5Trust in the Lord with all your heart;  
do not depend on your own understanding.

6Seek his will in all you do,  
and he will show you which path to take.” Proverbs 3: 5-6

'See, God has come to save me. I will trust in him and not be  
afraid. The Lord God is my strength and my song; he has given  
me victory.” ' Isaiah 12:2

## **PRAYER**

**Father, you are completely trustworthy and faithful. You have  
proven it time and again, and you don't even need to, but you have.**

**Forgive me for putting my trust in lesser things. I choose this day  
to trust in you with all my life and to let you direct my steps. I am  
done with trusting in the things of this world. I choose to trust you  
and step where and when you lead. I will not lean on what I know  
but trust in you and your word over my life. In Jesus' powerful  
name, amen.**

## **ACTION STEP**

- If you have a moment where you are worrying “it”, stop and pray. If you can worry about it, you can pray it.
- Day in and day out, make this declaration “I choose to put my trust in Jesus, He is always faithful and trustworthy.”
- Choose to trust Jesus and take that step of faith, Holy Spirit is never wrong in His leadership.
- Also keep going in this simple devotional

# Give Jesus your **FEAR**

## **SCRIPTURE**

'For God has not given us a spirit of fear and timidity, but of power, love, and self-discipline. ' 2 Timothy 1:7

'This is my command—be strong and courageous! Do not be afraid or discouraged. For the Lord your God is with you wherever you go.' ' Joshua 1:9

' "Don't be afraid of those who want to kill your body; they cannot touch your soul. Fear only God, who can destroy both soul and body in hell." ' Matthew 10:28

## **PRAYER**

**Father, I am done living in fear; I give you all my anxiety. You are with me, and because you are with me, nothing can stand against me. You didn't give me fear or timidity, so I don't want it, and I renounce its hold over me in Jesus' name. I choose to fear you alone, knowing you are God alone. I ask that you deliver me from all fear in Jesus' powerful name. Amen.**

## **ACTION STEP**

- Memorize the scriptures listed above along with Psalm 34: 4-5.
  - When you feel anxiety/fear quote these verses, stand on them.
- When you feel anxiety/fear pray the prayer listed above and make it your own.
- Also keep going in this simple devotional

# Give Jesus your **FAITH**

## **SCRIPTURE**

'For we live by faith, not by sight. ' 2 Corinthians 5:7

'So faith comes from hearing, that is, hearing the Good News about Christ. ' Romans 10:17

'Faith shows the reality of what we hope for; it is the evidence of things we cannot see. ' Hebrews 11:1

## **PRAYER**

**Father, I put my faith in you alone. You alone can save; you alone are all that I need. Forgive me for putting my faith in anything other than you. Father, help me to grow in my faith as I trust you. Help me to see what you are doing through faith, knowing that you are working all things together for my good. I choose to set my mind on your word. I choose to believe you and rest in you. In Jesus' most powerful name, amen.**

## **ACTION STEP**

- When doubts and lies creep in declare "I will place my faith in Jesus alone and stand on His word because it's completely true."
- Pray big faith filled prayers, that won't happen unless God shows up and does them.
- Choose to believe God day in and day out.
- Also keep going in this simple devotional

# Give Jesus your **JOB**

## **SCRIPTURE**

'In their hearts humans plan their course, but the Lord establishes their steps. ' Proverbs 16:9

'But seek first his kingdom and his righteousness, and all these things will be given to you as well. ' Matthew 6:33

'And whatever you do, whether in word or deed, do it all in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God the Father through him. ' Colossians 3:17

  - Work for them like Jesus was your boss
- Pray for your coworkers and bosses.
- Also keep going in this simple devotional

# Give Jesus your **DREAMS**

## **SCRIPTURE**

'Commit your actions to the Lord , and your plans will succeed. '  
Proverbs 16:3

'Trust in the Lord and do what is right! Settle in the land and maintain your integrity! Then you will take delight in the Lord , and he will answer your prayers. Commit your future to the Lord! Trust in him, and he will act on your behalf.' Psalms 37:3-5

## **SCRIPTURE**

"Father, if you are willing, please take this cup of suffering away from me. Yet I want your will to be done, not mine." ' Luke 22:42

"9Pray like this: Our Father in heaven, may your name be kept holy. 10 May your Kingdom come soon. May your will be done on earth, as it is in heaven." Matthew 6: 9-10

"7Submit yourselves, then, to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you. 8Come near to God and he will come near to you. Wash your hands, you sinners, and purify your hearts, you double-minded." James 4: 7-8

## **PRAYER**

**Father, I submit my will to you. I am done living for myself and chasing after my will. I trust you because you know what is best for me. I submit to your will for my life because your will is perfect where mine is so far from perfect. I choose this day to surrender all my will, preferences, and direction of my life to your will. ## **ACTION STEP**

- When you are about to make a big decision, stop first and then ask Jesus if this is His will for you.
  - Be willing and ready to lay down your will and preference for Jesus'.
- Every day choose to submit your will to our Father in Heaven, through both prayer and action.
- Also keep going in this simple devotional

# Give Jesus your **BODY**

## **SCRIPTURE**

“Don’t you realize that your body is the temple of the Holy Spirit, who lives in you and was given to you by God? You do not belong to yourself, for God bought you with a high price. So you must honor God with your body.” 1 Corinthians 6:19-20 NLT

'Therefore, I urge you, brothers and sisters, in view of God’s mercy, to offer your bodies as a living sacrifice, holy and pleasing to God—this is your true and proper worship. '

Romans 12:1

## **PRAYER**

**Father, I am grateful for the body you have blessed me with. Thank you for allowing me to worship you through my physical being. I ask that you remind me of your perspective on me and help me understand how my choices regarding my body reflect where you reside. Guide me to honor you with my physical body each day and treat my body with the utmost respect, recognizing it as your beautiful creation. I surrender my physical body to you, along with my selfish and sinful desires. I pray this in Jesus' name, amen.**

## **ACTION STEP**

- Where do you feel you have honored the Lord with your physical body? Where do you feel like you have NOT honored the Lord with your physical body?
- Ask the Lord to forgive any mistreatment of your body, whether that is with food, sexual desires, or harm.
- Ask the Lord to reveal to you areas where you need to give your body to Him completely.
- What can you do today to honor the Lord with your body?
- Ask the Lord to give you the strength, discipline, and desire to honor Him with your body.
- Also, keep going in this devotional.



# Give Jesus your **RELATIONSHIPS**

## **SCRIPTURE**

'So now I am giving you a new commandment: Love each other. Just as I have loved you, you should love each other.' John 13:34

"2Always be humble and gentle. Be patient with each other, making allowance for each other's faults because of your love. 3Make every effort to keep yourselves united in the Spirit, binding yourselves together with peace." Ephesians 4: 2-3

'Make allowance for each other's faults, and forgive anyone who offends you. Remember, the Lord forgave you, so you must forgive others.' Colossians 3:13

17Never pay back evil with more evil. Do things in such a way that everyone can see you are honorable. 18Do all that you can to live in peace with everyone. 19Dear friends, never take revenge. Leave that to the righteous anger of God. For the Scriptures say, "I will take revenge; I will pay them back," Romans 12: 17-19 says the Lord.

## **PRAYER**

**Father, I recognize that you are the most important relationship in my life. Please help me to honor you through every relationship that exists in my life. Give me wisdom and discernment to know if some relationships need to shift or end. Help me to build others up around me with your love. Help me to be patient and to be gracious with everyone. I choose to honor you with how I treat the people you have brought into my life. I pray this in Jesus' mighty name, amen.**

## **ACTION STEP**

- Choose each day to be a contributor and not a consumer.
  - Build others as you interact with them.
- Hand out encouragement like candy in kids church.
- Choose to pre-forgive any hurt.
  - Don't anticipate hurt in relationship but it will happen so pre-forgive
- Also keep going in this simple devotional
