1. Applicant or parent/guardian of the applicant must be a member or an active participant of Trinity for at least one year.
2. Applicants must currently be enrolled in a post-secondary institution, degree or certified program, i.e. university, college, technical or trade school.
3. Applicants cannot have been awarded a Trinity Lutheran Scholarship from this Church.
4. Recipients will be announced at the annual meeting in January, where they will receive the scholarship. If the recipient is unable to attend the meeting, a parent/guardian can receive it on their behalf.
