

## Our Response to COVID-19

- We encourage you to honor other people's standards on social distancing. Please be mindful that others may not feel comfortable receiving hugs or even handshakes. If you embrace another make sure they are comfortable with it.
- We will be welcoming and greeting by laying the bulletins on a table for you to grab on your own. A greeter will be in proximity to the table to welcome you.
- Masks are required per Executive Order 20-81. However, if you have any medical condition of any sort, we cannot stop you from entering without a face mask. We cannot legally ask you what your condition is. We have masks available should you need one.
- If you do not feel comfortable worshipping amongst a larger group of people we offer the worship service via video on a weekly basis that you can access on YouTube or RightNow Media.
- We encourage you to bring your own water bottles to limit the use of a drinking fountain.
- In following with state guidelines, we are operating at 50% capacity at Living Waters Church.
- Living Waters Church has one of its sections spaced out for social distancing. Please leave this section for those who might have concerns about COVID. In other words, if you are not worried about the virus for you or your family please leave that section for others. We will be marking off every other row and asking people to leave the designated rows empty.
- We will not be offering nursery services in the month of July. We will revisit this as we approach the month of August.
- We encourage people to fellowship outside after the conclusion of the worship service.
- We will be taking communion at the first service of each month. We will be using individual cups with both the cracker and juice built in. They will be stationed at the front of the church and everyone will be able to self-serve to avoid passing a plate around.
- Offering baskets will be available by the doors to the sanctuary.
