

From the Pastor's Pen

"Playing Catch as Connection"

"Again Jesus spoke to them, saying, "I am the light of the world. Whoever follows me will not walk in darkness, but will have the light of life." – John 8:12 ESV

On both of my deployments I made heavy use of the USO reading room. The USO provided a great program where a soldier could record a video of themselves reading a book and then mail that book (with included video) back to their family. The family could then watch the video and follow along in the book. One of the favorite books I sent to my family was "*Night Catch*" by Brenda Ehrmantraut. The premise of the book was that although the soldier and family were on opposite sides of the world, there was a simple way they could stay connected. Before the soldier went to sleep at night he would look at the North Star and figuratively "throw it" to the other side of the world. As the world spun and the family went about their business, the star would be traveling their way. Sure enough, half a day later the child could look outside their window at night, "catch" the North Star, and throw it back to their soldier before going to bed. As you might imagine, it was a clever, well-written book and highly emotional.

I've played catch with all four of my kids, but without a doubt I've played the most catch with my son Garrett. It's been one of those things we've been able to keep up throughout the years. If we have 5 minutes before supper, we play catch. If there's a few minutes before bed, we play catch. If the weather is unseasonably warm in late fall or early spring, we play catch. We've even played catch during commercial breaks while watching football and baseball games! There are few things that provide an instant connection like a couple baseball gloves and a ball.

Last week on the evening before Garrett moved away to college he asked me to "play catch." It became one of the most emotional moments of my life. We threw the ball much longer than normal. I knew my arm would make me pay for it the next day, but each toss was worth it. There was no reason to stop, no chore or task seemed more important than what I was doing at that moment. Time sped up and slowed down all at once. Images from t-ball to senior year flashed through my mind as the ball slapped against leather again and again. I soaked in every second, desperately wanting the moment to continue but knowing it couldn't.

I was an emotional puddle when Emma moved away to college two years ago and apparently I haven't changed since. It's a bit overwhelming to think I'm only half done emptying the nest! When you face a short-term separation, a long-term separation, or a new stage in life, *how thankful you become for moments of connection*.

Going back to the "*Night Catch*" idea I know we'll always have ways to connect as a family. We've endured separations in the past and we'll navigate whatever the future brings. In that book that still sits on our shelf, the North Star was the point of connection for a small family. How good it is as Christians to know we have a brighter light connecting a larger group. Indeed, *all Christians* are connected through the true light of the world. Having faith in Jesus assures us that others who also have faith in Jesus are in the same family. We'll enjoy that special family connection not just in this life, but in the life to come. As we look for ways to connect, what a blessing that we can look to Christ. He is our constant, He is the one who provides an everlasting connection.




