

From the Pastor's Pen

"Then one of them, when he saw that he was healed, turned back, praising God with a loud voice; ¹⁶ and he fell on his face at Jesus' feet, giving him thanks. Now he was a Samaritan. ¹⁷ Then Jesus answered, "Were not ten cleansed? Where are the nine?"

– Luke 17:15-17 ESV

In this passage Jesus had just cleansed ten lepers. When they realized they were healed, they must have been overjoyed! Even though they all experienced the same physical healing, only one returned to find Jesus and give him thanks. I don't ever want to be like one of those nine lepers who rejoices for a minute and then forgets to focus that thanksgiving on the one who brought the blessing.

Just recently I was reminded of a powerful example of God's goodness and blessing. Years ago, when Hannah was just 5 years old, we were in an accident in a side-by-side and she broke her femur. I remember seeing the x-ray on the screen even before the Dr came in and feeling my heart sink. Even with modern medicine and bone-setting techniques and hardware inserted in her leg, her recovery didn't go smoothly. Her leg did not heal straight and she had to have it reset. All in all, she experienced 3 surgeries... and that whole time my heart absolutely ached for her. I remember praying with one of the staff while she was recovering from the initial surgery asking for her to experience a full recovery. In my heart, I couldn't stand the thought of watching her limp through life, or her watching sporting events from the sideline. I wrestled with guilt and doubt that I might have taken those opportunities away from her during that wreck.

I prayed many things in those days... of course I prayed for God's will to be done. I prayed for patience and understanding on our part, I prayed that God would use this event to grow Hannah's faith and trust in the Lord. I also prayed for Hannah's physical recovery. I prayed for no limitations to set her back in life. This was the "above and beyond" part of my prayers.

This past month, I was reminded of God's incredible answer to those prayers. Hannah is now a freshman in high school and competed on the Kelly Walsh Cross Country team! She didn't participate in practice or competition the first few weeks because of a broken bone in her foot (horse stepped on her). But when she got going, she really got going! She improved her time every week and during the regional competition she took first place on JV! Her time was so good she earned a place on the State Varsity team! After that regional race I was overcome with thanksgiving to God. I recalled all those emotions and all those prayers from 9 years ago when I was uncertain if she'd ever run like a Peterson! Seeing her run so strong, leaving the rest of the field behind, and earning a spot on the State team made me realize how God worked in her life and answered my prayer "above and beyond what I could ask or think." She had come a long way from going to kindergarten in a wheelchair to running at State as an underclassmen!

Relating this story is just one way I can give thanks to God for the blessings He's worked in our lives. I don't ever want to be like one of the 9 lepers who forgot to give thanks to Jesus and acknowledge Him for His power. Take some time during this month that we dedicate to thanksgiving and take stock of all the blessings in your life. Think back upon your troubles and trials and remember how God has sustained you and lifted you up. Take some time to thank Him in your personal prayer life and don't be afraid to share with others the wonderful and remarkable things He's done for you.
