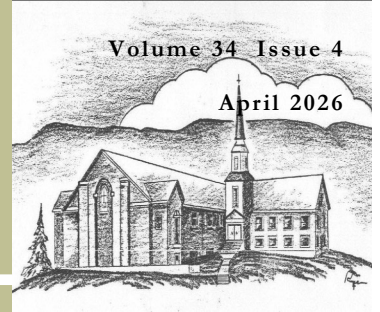

From the Pastor's Pen

“Texture and Timbre and Tone”

*“Praise the Lord! For it is good to sing praises to our God;
for it is pleasant, and a song of praise is fitting.” – Psalm 147:1 ESV*

As some of you know, I listen to a devotion most mornings provided by the Worship Initiative. It was founded by Christian musicians, “*Shane and Shane.*” One of the things I appreciate about their devotional is that they share a few thoughts and then they sing. And even though it’s a recording, they encourage you to sing along! More often than not, they make a special point to encourage you to sing even if you don’t consider yourself a good singer. They explain that God delights in hearing your praises to Him. I don’t know how many times I’ve heard them say, “Each one of you has your own texture and timbre and tone...” I don’t even know what timbre is (I had to look it up to see how to spell it). And I don’t know how texture applies to your voice, but I’m confident as accomplished musicians they know what they’re talking about!

I love the idea that even though you might not be a skilled vocalist God delights in hearing your individual offering of praise. Once in awhile Betsy and I get to listen to the devotional together and I love listening to her sing. Sometimes I prefer to stay quiet because I’d rather hear her voice than mine! However, on Sunday mornings I love to sing out as strong as I can! When you do that you find out there really is a different experience to be had when you sing praises to God as opposed to when you listen to others sing praises.

I want to encourage all of you to experience that difference as well. If you already sing out strong, thank you! I appreciate that you lift up your praise as an offering to the Lord. If you’re one who likes to hold back a little, preferring to let others do the praising, can I suggest that you at least try singing out? Open your mouth, stretch out those vocal cords, and let God hear your individual texture and tone and timbre (whatever that is). Join the others in a beautiful chorus of praise! You are God’s child, and he delights in hearing your voice!
