Honduras Mission Trip Overview
The Republic of Honduras is a developing
country in Central America. Today, Honduras is
among the most impoverished and economically
disadvantaged countries in the Latin America
and Caribbean region, with an estimated 48% of
the Honduran population (around 4.3 million
people) living in poverty (World Bank, 2020).

The Lord has graciously given 6 of us the privilege of serving Him this year by sharing with Hondurans the greatest gift there is to receive: **the good news of Jesus Christ**. We will be sharing about Christ while serving in the dental clinic for 3.5 days; leading songs, skits, crafts, snacks, memory verses, and games in VBS for 2 days; and ministering at Betania church.
