
Dear Friend,

Unwrapping Eternal Joy This Christmas

Each December here at Tecate Christian School, I always ponder ways to help my students focus on the *true meaning* of Christmas, which is the celebration of our Savior's birth.

As children are always excited about receiving presents, this year I thought it would be wonderful for my students to learn about and experience the *presents* we receive from Jesus. To do this, I did a study in the Bible on gifts we are given in Christ. I narrowed it down to thirteen gifts, since that is the number of students I have.

I then found physical items that represent each of these blessings at places like *The Dollar Store* and a few local thrift stores. Once I got the thirteen presents, I wrapped each one and placed it under our "Cross Christmas tree."

Every day in December, one student drew a name out of a box. Whoever's name was drawn that day got to open the *gift from Jesus*. Included with each gift was a detailed note explaining what the gift was and how the physical gift is related to the spiritual gift.

Following each gift being opened was a class discussion on the meaning of the gift and how we receive it. This ended up being a very meaningful lesson for the children as it led to a deeper understanding into God's character, His great love for us, and why God coming as *Emmanuel* is truly the greatest gift to each of us!









These are some of the gifts that were part of our "Gifts from Jesus."

Pack of Erasers (our sins taken away).

"I, even I, am He that blots out your transgressions for my own sake and will not remember your sins." ~ Isaiah 43:25. All our sins are forgiven when we surrender our life to Jesus.

Pen and Journal (our name written in the Book of Life).

"...rather rejoice, because your names are written in heaven." ~ Luke 10:20

"Nothing impure will ever enter it, nor will anyone who does what is shameful or deceitful, but only those whose names are written in the Lamb's book of life." ~ Revelation 21:27

When we know Christ as our Savior, our names are written in the Book of Life.

Mansion (a home in heaven).

"In my Father's house are many mansions: if it were not so, I would have told you. I go to prepare a place for you." ~ John 14:2

Jesus is preparing a place for us to live with Him in Heaven! You could also read Revelation 21:10-27, which describes the new Jerusalem and all the beautiful things that will be there.

Receipt, stamped "Paid in Full" in rugged, wood frame (our sin debt paid).

"For the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord." ~ Romans 6:23

Jesus paid our sin debt by dying on the cross for our sins.

Framed Adoption Certificate (adopted into God's family).

"Having predestinated us unto the adoption of children by Jesus Christ to himself, according to the good pleasure of his will...for you are no longer foreigners and strangers, but fellow citizens with God's people and also members of his household," ~ Ephesians 1:5 & 2:19


What a blessing to be adopted into the family of God, to be joint heirs with Christ.


Nativity Scene Night Light (the gift of Jesus coming into our world).
