WEEK 1

ACTIVITY | Have You Scene It?

- O Eye Found It" game from Disney
- O *optional:* instead design a DIY version like this <u>sample</u>

ACTIVITY | Fairytale Friends

- O paper
- O pencils
- O colored pencils

WHAT TO PREP: Print out or project the images for these step-by-step drawing instructions: <u>mouse</u>, <u>horse</u>, <u>bird</u>, or instructions worksheet linked in the description of <u>this video</u>.

BIG IDEA | God gives us companions.

WHAT TO PREP: Write the Big Idea on a piece of paper, roll it up, and tie with string.

OBJECT LESSON | Shadow Companion

- O chalk
- O washable markers
- O butcher paper
- O flashlights

REFLECTION | The Lion and the Mouse

WHAT TO PREP: Get a copy of the story, "The Lion and the Mouse," or play a video like <u>this one</u>.

RESPONSE | Once Upon a Time

- O paper
- O drawing tools
- O scissors

WHAT TO PREP: Check out <u>this tutorial</u> to create a worked example of this activity.

MEMORY VERSE | Hansel and Gretel's Trail

- O paper
- O marker

WHAT TO PREP: Write out each word of the memory verse (Psalm 121:8) on its own paper, along with more words not in the verse. You may choose to tear the edges of the paper to make them look like giant bread crumbs.

ACTIVITY | Pick a Pal

- O printable
- O writing/drawing tools

ACTIVITY | Grains of Hope

- O yellow construction paper

ACTIVITY | One-Sentence Story

- O index cards
- O pencils
- O 2 bins

BIBLE STORY | Ruth Asks Boaz for Help

- O costume for Storybook Maker
- O laptop or typewriter (or parchment and quill)

BIG IDEA | God gives us boldness.

O same materials as week 1

WHAT TO PREP: Write the Big Idea on a piece of paper, roll it up, and tie with string.

ACTIVITY | Story Timeline

- O story timeline worksheet (like these)
- O colored pencils or crayons

OBJECT LESSON | Fear Box

- O 4 tissue boxes
- O cooked spaghetti or ramen noodles
- O toy spider
- O slime
- O feathers

BIBLE | Psalm 42

WHAT TO PREP: Write or project Psalm 42:5(11).

REFLECTION | Mulan's Boldness

WHAT TO PREP: Queue up <u>this clip</u> (or a part of it) from Mulan (2020). You could also choose to show the <u>animated version</u>.

RESPONSE | Plan to be Bold

- O printable
- O scissors
- O glue

MEMORY VERSE | Beanstalk Bible Verse

- O green pool noodles
- O green construction paper
- O markers
- O painter's tape

WHAT TO PREP: Prepare a <u>fake beanstalk</u> by using green pool noodles. Write the words of the memory verses on green construction paper and tape them in any order around the pool noodles.

ACTIVITY | Coat of Arms

- O printable
- O drawing tools
- O *optional:* metallic markers, glitter glue, stickers

BIG IDEA | God always takes care of us.

- O same materials as week 1
- O handkerchief (or tissue)

WHAT TO PREP: Write the Big Idea on a piece of paper, roll it up, and tie with string.

OBJECT LESSON | Caring for Others

O stuffed animal or picture/video of a pet (or your own)

BIBLE | Matthew 6:26-34

O Genealogy map (or similar)

REFLECTION | The Elves and the Shoemaker

WHAT TO PREP: Obtain a copy of the book, "The Elves and the Shoemaker" (or show a read-aloud video like <u>this one</u>).

RESPONSE | Always There

- O poster board or dry erase board
- O markers
- O sticky notes
- O pencils

WHAT TO PREP: On a poster board or dry erase board, draw a <u>Venn Diagram</u>. Draw a sad face on one side and a happy face on the other side.

ACTIVITY | Caring Doors

- O craft sticks
- O buttons
- O duct tape
- O fine point markers
- O wood glue or hot glue
- O craft knife or wood shears
- O sandpaper
- O optional: wood paint and brushes

WHAT TO PREP: Cut some craft sticks in half using a craft knife or wood shears and sand it down.
