WEEK 1

ACTIVITY | God Made The World

- WHAT TO GET:
 - [Inflatable globe](#)
- WHAT TO PREP: Fill up the inflatable globe with air.

SCRIPTURE | Genesis 1:1-2:4a (In the Beginning)

- WHAT TO GET:
 - LEGO Duplo bricks
- WHAT TO PREP: Feel free to use [this video](#) of the story shown with LEGOs as an additional teaching tool before you tell the story or to review afterward. Test the video beforehand, including checking that no ads will pop up if you are streaming it.

BIG IDEA | God makes good things.

- WHAT TO GET:
 - LEGO Duplo bricks
 - Repositionable labels
- WHAT TO PREP: Print a set of the Big Idea words on repositionable labels, 1 word per label. Place word labels on the sides of the bricks, 1 word per brick. You can also print 1 phrase per label, like [this](#), instead.

ACTIVITY | Creation Hop

- WHAT TO GET:
 - Creation Hop printable
 - Tape
- WHAT TO PREP: Print the Creation Hop printable onto cardstock, then tape the 7 images to the floor in order in a line or a circle.

SNACK | Yummy Creation

- WHAT TO GET:
 - Zip bags or paper bowls
 - Oreo cookies
 - M&M's (blue, green, and yellow)
 - Chex rice cereal
 - Swedish fish
 - Animal crackers
 - Gummy bears
- WHAT TO PREP: Make one premade bag or bowl of trail mix for each kid. Consider allergies and make substitutions as necessary.

- WHAT TO GET:
 - [Inflatable globe](#)
- WHAT TO PREP: Inflate the inflatable globe.

ACTIVITY | World of Good Things

- WHAT TO GET:
 - Week 1 Big Idea printable
 - Liquid glue or glue dots
 - [6" Paper plates](#)
 - Blue and green crayons or markers
 - [Animal stickers](#)
 - [Themed foam stickers](#)
 - [Star stickers](#)
 - [People stickers](#)
- WHAT TO PREP: Print this week's Big Idea printable on cardstock paper.

ACTIVITY | Coloring Page

- WHAT TO GET:
 - Crayons or markers
 - Printable
- WHAT TO PREP: Print a coloring page for each kid.

ACTIVITY | Play Dough Build

- WHAT TO GET:
 - Play dough
 - [Play dough tools](#)

ACTIVITY | Creation Sensory Bin

- WHAT TO GET:
 - Large bin(s)
 - Blue water beads
 - Animal figurines
 - People figurines (e.g., LEGO people, Little People, etc.)
 - Fake flowers
 - Small squares of fake grass
 - Glow stars and moon
 - White and black beans or beads
 - [Ocean sensory kit](#) (optional)
- WHAT TO PREP: Fill a large bin with an assortment of the above supplies. You can use [this picture](#) as inspiration. Feel free to substitute any of the above supplies for other objects that represent the days of creation.

WEEK 2

ACTIVITY | Fix It

- WHAT TO PREP: Set up items around the room that need to be "fixed." Here are some examples you can prepare:
 - Tear a few different color sheets of paper into 2-4 pieces. Pair them with tape for kids to put back together.
 - Print a few pictures of someone with a scrape, such as [this picture](#). Pair this with adhesive bandages that kids can put on the picture.
 - Deconstruct a puzzle that kids can put together.
 - Pair a baby doll with gauze. Create a scenario, like the baby hurt their arm, and have kids wrap the baby with gauze.

ACTIVITY | Wreck It

- WHAT TO GET:
 - Paper towel or toilet paper tubes
- WHAT TO PREP: Cut paper towel tubes or toilet paper tubes into shorter lengths. You could also use cardboard blocks or foam blocks instead.

SCRIPTURE | Genesis 3 (The Fall)

- WHAT TO GET:
 - LEGO Duplo bricks
 - 2 LEGO Duplo people figurines (1 boy and 1 girl)
 - [LEGO baseplate](#) (optional)
- WHAT TO PREP: Combine the LEGO Duplo people with the bricks. Within your collection of bricks, make sure you have enough green, brown, and red bricks in order to make a tree [like this](#) and a fruit [like this](#). Practice assembling them beforehand. Feel free to use [this video](#) of the story shown with LEGOs as an additional teaching tool before you tell the story or to review afterward. Test the video beforehand, including checking that no ads will pop up if you are streaming it.

BIG IDEA | God unbreaks what's been broken.

- WHAT TO GET:
 - LEGO Duplo bricks
 - Repositionable labels
- WHAT TO PREP: Print a set of the Big Idea words on repositionable labels, 1 word per label. Place word labels on the sides of the bricks, 1 word per brick. You can also print 1 phrase per label, like [this](#), instead. Feel free to

swap out the word "unbreaks" for "fixes" if you'd like.

- **WHAT TO PREP:** Print a coloring page for each kid.

SNACK | Garden Fruit

- **WHAT TO GET:**
 - Plates
 - Sliced apples
 - [Gummy snakes](#)
- **WHAT TO PREP:** Cut apples into slices or purchase packaged apple slices from your local grocery store.

ACTIVITY | Circle Time

- **WHAT TO GET:**
 - An apple (real or fake)

ACTIVITY | God Can Fix It

- **WHAT TO GET:**
 - Construction paper
 - Stickers or washi tape
 - [Perforator](#)
- **WHAT TO PREP:** Create large hearts out of construction paper, one for each kid. Fold each heart in half and run a [perforator](#) down that center line.

ACTIVITY | Coloring Page

- **WHAT TO GET:**
 - Crayons or markers
 - Printable

ACTIVITY | Unbreaking Station

- **WHAT TO GET:**
 - Toy tool sets
 - Pull-apart toys
 - Dolls or stuffed animals
 - Doctor or dentist play kits
 - Construction paper
 - Glue
 - Pre-ripped papers
- **WHAT TO PREP:** Set out different stations for kids to "fix" things. Here are some examples: toy tool sets, adhesive bandages and dolls or stuffed animals, construction paper with glue and ripped papers, etc.

ACTIVITY | Building Station

- **WHAT TO GET:**
 - Wood blocks
 - Foam blocks
 - Magnet tiles
 - LEGO Duplo bricks
 - Mega Bloks
 - Lincoln Logs
- **WHAT TO PREP:** Choose any of the above building materials to set out for the kids.

WEEK 3

ACTIVITY | Playing Favorites

- **WHAT TO GET:**
 - Floor tape
- **WHAT TO PREP:** Lay down a line of tape on the floor long enough for your whole class to stand on comfortably. Test [this video](#) [0:15-7:27] beforehand, including checking that no ads will pop up if you are streaming it.

ACTIVITY | Different is Special!

- **WHAT TO PREP:** Watch [this video](#) [0:10-0:23] of how to play the human knot game.

SCRIPTURE | Genesis 4:1-16 (Cain and Abel)

- **WHAT TO GET:**
 - LEGO Duplo bricks
 - [LEGO baseplate](#) (optional)
- **WHAT TO PREP:** Within your collection of bricks, make sure you have enough of three different colors of your choice in order to make two hearts [like this](#) and also a large heart outline on the LEGO baseboard or the floor. Practice assembling them beforehand. Feel free to use [this video](#) of the story shown with LEGOs as an additional teaching tool before you tell the story or to review afterward. Test the video beforehand,

including checking that no ads will pop up if you are streaming it.

BIG IDEA | God made us different on purpose.

- **WHAT TO GET:**
 - LEGO Duplo bricks
 - Repositionable labels
- **WHAT TO PREP:** Print a set of the Big Idea words on repositionable labels, 1 word per label. Place word labels on the sides of the bricks, 1 word per brick.

ACTIVITY | The Different Dance

- **WHAT TO PREP:** Prepare to play "[We're All Amazing](#)" ([London Rhymes](#)). Test the song beforehand, including checking that no ads will pop up if you are streaming it.

SNACK | Waffle Faces

- **WHAT TO GET:**
 - Toaster waffles
 - Toppings (e.g., M&Ms, blueberries, sliced strawberries, pretzel sticks, etc.)
 - Paper plates
 - Bowls
- **WHAT TO PREP:** Heat up the toaster waffles and place them on plates. Choose toppings, such as the ones suggested above, that kids can use to make eyes, noses, and mouths, and place them into bowls.

ACTIVITY | Circle Time

- **WHAT TO GET:**
 - [Shape sorting cube](#)
- **WHAT TO PREP:** Choose upbeat music to play. Test the song(s) beforehand, including checking that no ads will pop up if you are streaming it.

ACTIVITY | The Me God Made

- **WHAT TO GET:**
 - [Square adhesive acrylic mirrors](#) (1 per kid)
 - Cardstock
 - Glue
 - Decoration materials (e.g., pom poms, pipe cleaners, foam stickers, wax sticks, yarn, etc.)
- **WHAT TO PREP:** Remove protective film from the [adhesive mirrors](#) if needed. Use various colors of cardstock paper if you have them available, then cut the papers in half so that there is enough for 1 piece per kid. Gather various materials, like the items suggested above, for kids to decorate their paper with. (See a worked example [here](#).)

ACTIVITY | Coloring Page

- **WHAT TO GET:**
 - Crayons or markers
 - Printable
- **WHAT TO PREP:** Print a coloring page for each kid.

ACTIVITY | The Amazing Madrigals

- **WHAT TO GET:**
 - Classroom instruments
- **WHAT TO PREP:** Prepare to show the music video, "[The Family Madrigal](#)" from [Encanto](#). Test the video beforehand, including checking that no ads will pop up if you are streaming it.

ACTIVITY | Magnetic Blocks

- **WHAT TO GET:**
 - Magnet tiles (e.g., Magna-Tiles)
 - Lighted table or LED tracing pad (optional)

WEEK 4

ACTIVITY | Topple a Tower

- Jenga block sets
- **WHAT TO PREP:** *Check your local Dollar Tree store, or similar store, to see if you can find Jenga games for \$1!*

ACTIVITY | Can You Build What I Build?

- Blocks or LEGO Duplo bricks
- 2 Buckets
- **WHAT TO PREP:** *Build a tower, or a simple shape, out of blocks or LEGO Duplo bricks ahead of time. Fill 2 buckets with an assortment of blocks. If using Duplo bricks, make sure there are enough bricks in each bucket that exactly match colors and quantities of the bricks you used to make your build since kids will be copying it.*

SCRIPTURE | Genesis 11:1-9 (The Tower of Babel)

- LEGO Duplo bricks
- 1 Bucket or container
- **WHAT TO PREP:** *Optionally, have only one color of bricks available to use as a way to demonstrate sameness –the people in the story wanted to stay together in the same place, and they all spoke the same language. Feel free to use [this video](#) of the story shown with LEGOs as an additional teaching tool before you tell the story or to review afterward. Test the video beforehand, including checking that no ads will pop up if you are streaming it.*

ACTIVITY | Babbling Babel

- **WHAT TO GET:**
 - [Animal stickers](#) or [stamps](#)

SNACK | Build-A-Snack

- Food items (e.g., pretzel sticks and cheese cubes, Pocky sticks and marshmallows, gum drop candy and candy cane sticks, etc.)
- Bowls
- **WHAT TO PREP:** *Choose food items that kids can use to build with, such as the suggestions above. Place your chosen food items into bowls.*

ACTIVITY | Circle Time

- 1 block or cube

ACTIVITY | Keep God in the Frame

- Craft glue
- Instant camera with film (optional)
