

**Sermon: Faith Filled, Big Thinking**  
**Series: Jesus and We**

**Hebrews 11:1**

Now faith is confidence in what we hope for and assurance about what we do not see.

**Christian faith is “faith in...”**

Faith does not save us, faith in Jesus saves us.

Our faith does not move mountains, God moves mountains.

Our faith just needs to be the size of a mustard seed.

**Christian faith is not blind faith.**

**Hebrews 11:3, 6**

By faith we **understand** that the entire universe was formed at God’s command, that what we now see did not come from anything that can be seen.

And it is impossible to please God without faith. Anyone who wants to come to him **must believe that God exists** and that he rewards those who sincerely seek him.

**Christian Faith impacts how we live, what we do.**

**Hebrews 11:4**

It was by faith that Abel brought a more acceptable offering to God than Cain did.

Abel’s offering gave evidence that he was a righteous man, and God showed his approval of his gifts.

When we allow something other than what we know is true about God, to dictate our actions, then we are not living true to our faith.

**Christian faith always, always asks us to make a commitment.**

**Hebrews 11:8**

8 It was by faith that **Abraham obeyed** when God called him to leave home and go to another land that God would give him as his inheritance. **He went without knowing where he was going.**

Commitment is always a leap.

**What kind of commitment is required of Christian faith?**

Total commitment. A giving over of our lives to Jesus.

**Have you ever prayed that kind of commitment prayer to Jesus?**

Jesus says to us, I give my life for you. I ask that you give your life to me.
