## Unity and Diversity

Superheroes have lots of different skills and super powers. What super power would you like to have? But, some villains and problems are too big for one hero to handle on their own. So heroes team up. What is your favorite super hero team: the Avengers? the Incredibles? the Justice League? the Power Rangers?

When superheroes team up they have to learn how to use their unique abilities together. That isn't easy. They often disagree on how to fight the bad guy. They get in each other's way.

It's not easy to learn how to work as a team.

In this week's Bible passage, Paul talks about how God made the church out of a lot of different people, with different skills and talents, but God calls us to love and work together. We are all different people. We are all unique. But, we are also all people God made and God loves. We are all people Jesus died for. We all have the Holy Spirit working in our lives. The Church is God's super hero team to save the world!
