Ephesians 4:1-6**

How many times is "one" repeated?

The one we follow, the one we serve is one, unified. John 10:30; 17:21

What kind of effort are we to make to be unified?

So as a church we are to be unified, but we can be unified around the wrong things or at least not the best things.

So what is it that should unify us?

Look at the "therefore". What does that refer to? (1:3-8; 2:4-7, 10; 3:14-21)

The very next thing that Paul writes is "therefore"...

Paul begs us to live a life worthy of our calling...

So who in God's church do you need to reach out to?

Who comes to mind?

What are going to do about it?
