Sermon Outline:

"The God of Miracles"

John 6:1–21

(John 6:1-2) After this, Jesus crossed over to the far side of the Sea of Galilee, also known as the Sea of Tiberias. ² A huge crowd kept following him wherever he went, because they saw his miraculous signs as he healed the sick.

What's a Miracle – A miracle is an extraordinary event manifesting divine intervention in human affairs.

The greatest miracle in life is God invading humanity in the form of Jesus.

(Colossians 1:27MSG) God wanted everyone, not just Jews, to know this rich and glorious secret inside and out, regardless of their background, regardless of their religious standing. The mystery in a nutshell is just this: Christ is in you, therefore you can look forward to sharing in God's glory. It's that simple. That is the substance of our Message.

God can move mountains but He'd rather move your heart.

We must all be careful to not just seek the hand of God, but rather seek the face of God.

Miracles are good, but blessings are better.

A miracle is an extraordinary event, but blessings are perpetual.

(John 4:13-14) Jesus replied, "Anyone who drinks this water will soon become thirsty again. But those who drink the water I give will never be thirsty again. It becomes a fresh, bubbling spring within them, giving them eternal life."

You can experience a miracle, but still become thirsty for sin. You can be healed, but not be made whole.

5 basic blessings that Jesus brings through salvation:

- 1. His Spirit Will Be with Us: (Psalms 91:14-16)**
- 2. He Can Give Us Strength to Resist Temptation (Titus 2:11-12)**
- 3. His Example Will Guide Us/ Vision: (Hebrews 12:2)**
- 4. He Can Help Us Serve Others: (Luke 6:38)**
- 5. We Can Repent: (1 John 1:9)**

Response – Ask God to give you a revelation of the name Jesus. How beautiful, how marvelous, how capable that name is.
