



General Info Youth Camps

Registration: 10:00 – 11:30 on Monday (lunch is at noon). Camp ends on Saturday, pick up time is 8:30 A.M.

All medication must be in the original container and be turned in and distributed by the camp nurse.

What to Bring: Bible, Pen, Bedding, Towels, Toiletries, Camera, Musical Instruments, Spending Money (Offering, Crafts, Gift Store, Snacks, Boats, Paintball for Jr. & Sr. High Only)

Do not Bring: Listening Devices, Video Games, Phone, Drugs, Tobacco, Alcohol, Knives, Firearms, or Fireworks

Clothing: Modest, not tight fitting. Shorts should be at least mid-thigh in length. Skirts at least to the knee. No leggings or tank tops. Teen and adult men: no athletic/mesh shorts for climbing tower or zipline. Swimwear: A t-shirt worn for all water activities; a cover worn to and from the pool/lakefront. One-piece swimsuit or an overlapping tankini for girls, swim trunks for guys.

Campers leaving early must have written permission signed by legal guardian stating time and name of the driver. The camp reserves the right to refuse dismissal without proper identification.

Visitors: For the safety of our campers and continuity our program, all visitors must receive permission from IRBC two weeks in advance to visit youth camps.
