

An individual's choice to work towards a team's common goal—the goal is part of a cause bigger than any one person.

Consistency in the past, effort at the present, and promise for the future.

2 Thessalonians 3:3-5—God is faithful!

There is one God and many idols—you can only be committed to one. Yes to one is no to all others. Matthew 6:24—you can't serve two masters.

Trust is the residue of promises kept and includes a difficult ingredient, the lack of understanding. Proverbs 3:5–6—trust in the Lord; don't lean on your understanding.

Worthy cause, all to the glory of God. 1 Corinthians 10:31—do all to the glory of God.

I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that ye present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable unto God, which is your reasonable service. And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what is that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God.

The effort of giving, using, or spending of time, energy, talents, strengths, and gifts

Figure out the next step and do it.

Involves sweat, sore muscles, and tired body—give 100% back to God!

This life is one long row of sowing. Don't be deceived! You will reap based on your sowing (Galatians 6:7); even the smallest of action like a cup of cold water (Mark 9:41).

Time is a gift that is wasted or invested. The work may be the same, but the cause changes the value of the time spent.

Uni-presence—you can only be and do one thing at a time. This allows you to have priorities and requires you to say no to so many other possibilities.

So built we the wall; and all the wall was joined together unto the half thereof: for the people had a mind to work. They which builded on the wall, and they that bare burdens, with those that laded, every one with one of his hands wrought in the work, and with the other hand held a weapon. For the builders, every one had his sword girded by his side, and so builded. And he that sounded the trumpet was by me.

For he that soweth to his flesh shall of the flesh reap corruption; but he that soweth to the Spirit shall of the Spirit reap life everlasting. And let us not be weary in well doing: for in due season we shall reap, if we faint not. As we have therefore opportunity, let us do good unto all men, especially unto them who are of the household of faith.

The process of interaction that shares meaning and results in understanding for the participants

Honestly appraise the impact of your decisions upon the team's mission.

Grow a vocabulary of words that mean the same thing to everyone on the team.

<u>Timely</u> and <u>available</u> are two ways to make communication more effective.

Communication is a gauge of loving others. When you consider how decisions and information affects others, you work to communicate with them.

Consider source, message, channel, receiver, attention, distraction, feedback, and context.

And the LORD said, Behold, the people is one, and they have all one language; and this they begin to do: and now nothing will be restrained from them, which they have imagined to do. Go to, let us go down, and there confound their language, that they may not understand one another's speech.

To become different, which results in the option of taking next steps

Nobody likes change because of the need to adjust in order to keep balance. Change keeps knocking us off balance.

Loss of control during the process of change requires trust in someone other than yourself.

Change creates ripples. A large ripple is called a tsunami. Every change creates more changes. Positive and negative impacts are anticipated, uncertain, and unpredictable.

It is impossible to grow without change.

Slow change can mask the need to adjust, and fast change can cause overadjustments.

Therefore if any man be in Christ, he is a new creature: old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new.

2 CORINTHIANS 5:17

Division which results in opposition, differences, or difficulty


Personal conflict and process conflict have huge differences. Confusing the two destroys teams.

A house divided among itself can cause the same destruction as an enemy opposed to a house.

Satan is the enemy of God and seeks to destroy what God made and loves.

Unresolved personal conflict results in lonely living.

God is bigger than any enemy, person, or circumstance. Be still and know three things about God (Psalm 46:10–11)—He is bigger than any man, is bigger than the earth, and is with us right now.


The sum of the characteristics possessed by a person—internal attitudes, motivations, intents, and beliefs that eventually show up as actions.

Character results in actions but resides in your heart and is truly only known by you and God.

How do you routinely react? What do you consistently initiate? See the story of David and Goliath in 1 Samuel 17:28–50.

Godly character means you believe what God says. A person without character listens to their feelings and is fooled by devil's lies (Proverbs 1:1–7).

Character is what kicks in when you don't feel like it or when the shiny wears off.



And beside this, giving all diligence, add to your faith virtue; and to virtue knowledge; And to knowledge temperance; and to temperance patience; and to patience godliness; And to godliness brotherly kindness; and to brotherly kindness charity. For if these things be in you, and abound, they make you that ye shall neither be barren nor unfruitful in the knowledge of our Lord Jesus Christ.

2 PETER 1:5-8

And not only so, but we glory in tribulations also: knowing that tribulation worketh patience: And patience, experience; and experience. hope: And hope maketh not ashamed: because the love of God is shed abroad in our hearts by the Holy Ghost which is given unto us. ROMANS 5:3-5

But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace. longsuffering, gentleness, goodness, faith. Meekness, temperance: against such there is no law. GALATIANS 5:22-23



Unique individual with talent and gifting who plays his or her part within the team

Strategic interdependence—foundation of the relationship is in their need or desire to be together.

Be with and do with—creation of relationship when people do enough together that they also enjoy just being together. Balance of the two keeps a relationship from getting stale.

Willing and able—sometimes our brain tries to do something that our body, talents, or gifting does not allow for.

Five-, two-, and one-talent people—God made them all different (Matthew 25:14–30) and requires 100% use of their talents, not equal results.

12For as the body is one, and hath many members, and all the members of that one body, being many, are one body: so also is Christ.

14For the body is not one member, but many.

15If the foot shall say, Because I am not the hand, I am not of the body; is it therefore not of the body?

18But now hath God set the members every one of them in the body, as it hath pleased him.

24For our comely parts have no need: but God hath tempered the body together, having given more abundant honour to that part which lacked:

25That there should be no schism in the body; but that the members should have the same care one for another.

THE GEARS OF TEAMWORK CHALLENGE

A reason big enough to form a team; a mission, task, goal, problem, or cause worth spending time, resources, and effort on

Boil all challenges/missions/goals down to two categories: God-centered or self-centered.

Bigger than any one person—the challenge creates the need for a team to work together.

Create reminders of what the challenge is. Sometimes the work being accomplished is so far removed from the end goal that we forget what work we are a part of.

Obedience to God is our #1 priority. We are involved in multiple challenges across the various roles in our life.

For I have no man likeminded, who will naturally care for your state. For all seek their own, not the things which are Jesus Christ's. But ye know the proof of him, that, as a son with the father, he hath served with me in the gospel.

Philippians 2:20-22

For our light affliction, which is but for a moment, worketh for us a far more exceeding and eternal weight of glory; While we look not at the things which are seen, but at the things which are not seen: for the things which are seen are temporal; but the things which are not seen are eternal.

2 CORINTHIANS 4:17-18



The end! Faith in the future reign of God, our Alpha and Omega.

Faith is believing on the unseen things talked of in the Bible so that I act as if they are reality. See the example of Moses in Hebrews 11:24–27 choosing God over Pharaoh.

Step back far enough to get an eternal perspective.

The conclusion is known: God wins! This fact allows all those with Him to have peace, hope, and rest.

The conclusion of our spiritual warfare is not the conclusion of our existence.

Who shall separate us from the love of Christ? shall tribulation, or distress, or persecution, or famine, or nakedness, or peril, or sword? As it is written. For thy sake we are killed all the day long; we are accounted as sheep for the slaughter. Nay, in all these things we are more than conquerors through him that loved us. For I am persuaded, that neither death, nor life, nor angels, nor principalities, nor powers, nor things present, nor things


And, behold, I come quickly; and my reward is with me, to give every man according as his work shall be. I am Alpha and Omega, the beginning and the end, the first and the last.
