The Bible Story: Hezekiah Loved God, **based on 2 Chronicles 29**

Life Point: People show God they love Him.

Bible Story:

- King Hezekiah told the people to come to the temple (church) to help clean it.
- The people worked and worked until the temple was clean.
- The next day King Hezekiah told the people to come back to the temple.
- The people worshiped to show God they loved Him.

Live it Out: Gather items that your child can open and close, such as books, a shoe box, etc. Gather a blank piece of paper and art supplies such as crayons and stickers. Say “open and close” as you and your child open and close the items. Talk about how the temple was closed but Hezekiah opened it. Fold a blank sheet of paper in half. Print the Life Point (above) on the paper. Open and close the paper. Invite your child to decorate the paper with crayons or stickers.

Threes-Kindergarten

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Life Point: People show God they love Him.

Review Questions:

- When Hezekiah became king was the temple opened or closed? (Closed)
- What did Hezekiah want to do first before the people could worship? (clean and repair the temple)
- What did all the people do once the temple was ready? (went to the temple and worshiped God)

Live it Out: Use chairs to create a pretend car. Use a paper or plastic plate as a steering wheel. Encourage your child to “drive” you to church. Talk about cars you pretend to see on the way. Talk about how Hezekiah made sure the temple was cleaned and repaired so the people could gather and worship. Talk about ways your child can show love to God.



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
