

PFYC 2021 UPDATE!

Dear Pastors, Youth Pastors, and Youth Leaders:

We wanted to pass along important information concerning our March 24th – 26th, 2021 *Pentecostal Fire Youth Conference*. The LeConte Center is only allowing 3,600 seats for our event. As you know, this is well under the number that usually attends. **To remedy the possibility of people showing up and not having a seat, we have decided to transition to a SEAT RESERVATION SYSTEM.** Upon reaching the maximum capacity of 3,600, tickets sales will be closed and there will be no more availability to attend!

How do I reserve my seat(s)?

- On Sunday, February 14th @ 10 pm EST each church group can reserve their block of seats (*minimum of 9 seat block*) by going to iTickets.com and searching for PFYC.
- On Wednesday, February 17th individual seat reservations of any number can be purchased on iTickets.com.

Tip: If you wish for your group to sit together, each church should reserve its tickets together in one purchase.

Note: This is not to favor the large churches but rather to give the youth groups priority time to register as they need seating in larger blocks. Smaller groups, families and individuals can more easily fill in the open areas between the larger groups at a later date. Thank you for understanding.

How much does it cost to reserve a seat?

An offering of \$35 (per seat) will be required for your iTicket reservation purchase. This fee is for the entire event. The fee is the same for all ages.

Note: Offerings will not be received at the conference.

Can I choose the location of my seats?

Yes! When you log onto iTickets.com you will have the option to choose the location of any available seats.

Are my tickets refundable?

Your tickets are transferable but not refundable.

Note: If for some unforeseen reason the conference is canceled, your seat reservation fee of \$30 only will be refunded. The \$5 processing fee would not be refunded.

Other things to note:

- Masks are required by the LeConte Center.
- Leaders will be asked to take the temperatures of their church members before bringing their groups to the LeConte Center. Anyone having a temperature exceeding 100.4 will not be permitted.
- In the event that the LeConte Center relaxes its COVID-19 guidelines, we will immediately make additional seats available. (Those who have reserved seats will keep their preferred selections and only be moved forward as the seat pattern tightens.)
