Matthew 6:19-24

1. It has been said that if you make more than \$48,000, you are in the top 1 percent of wage earners in the world. How does that make you feel? Do you agree or disagree?
2. Finances seems to be an area we struggle to talk about with others. Why do you think that is?
3. Talk about a time when you gave to someone in need. How did it make you feel?
4. As people who are living on the top end of Maslow's hierarchy of needs, it's easy for us to desire more. In the message today, we heard these words "*the best antidote for materialism is giving.*" Wealth and God will always be competing for your affections and heart. What are some ways to prevent this from happening?
5. We also heard today that it's really not about our worldly treasures but rather about the current of our heart and affections. Do you agree that if your heart is focused on eternal things, the things of this world grow dim?
6. Read I Timothy 6:19 together as a group. Talk about this idea of creating "a firm foundation for the coming age" with your generosity. Does that idea resonate with you?
