Actual General Fund receipts from June 1, 2017 through November 30, 2017 totaled approximately \$333,000 compared to budgeted receipts of \$406,000 or a \$73,000 shortfall to budget. Actual accrued expenses for the same period totaled \$394,000 or a \$61,000 actual shortfall.

As of October 31, 2017, the Timothy Tuition Assistance obligation for the

2017-2018 school year was approximately \$60,000.
