

MidNaz Worship Team Commitment and Expectations

To create a distraction-free environment where people can connect, worship and hear from God.

1. ***Spiritual Preparation and Reflection:*** Worship on a platform is the overflow of a lifestyle that reflects our relationship with Christ and of a heart that is well-cultivated by God throughout the week. We ask that you spend time on a regular basis in God's Word and in conversation with God through prayer. We also ask that - as leaders - you strive to live a life that reflects Jesus to the world in how we talk, act and communicate through social media. In short, we are Jesus' ambassadors, showing the world who God is, what God cares about and who God cares about.

2. ***Musical Preparation:*** Being prepared means listening and practicing the scheduled music prior to rehearsal. It also means having any equipment or music you intend to use on Sunday with you.

3. ***Attitude:*** Ideas or suggestions should be presented and received with a good attitude. If there are technical, musical or miscellaneous complications, keep attitudes positive and morale high. Be open to constructive criticism and correction from the worship leader.

4. ***Punctuality:*** Everyone's time is valuable. It's important that everyone be punctual for rehearsals maximizing our limited time. Being on time demonstrates respect. If an unexpected situation arises and you know you will be late, please communicate as quickly as possible with the worship leader.

5. ***Dress:*** We want to present ourselves in a way that keeps the focus on God. In short, we want to avoid drawing attention to ourselves, and we want to project a clean, neat and modest appearance. A few basic guidelines include: (i) shoulders and the mid-section to be completely covered at all times -- no low cut tops; (ii) skirts and dresses should fall at the knee; (iii) hats, shorts and any article of clothing with questionable text or graphics should not be worn; (iv) dress sandals are fine, but no flip flops; and (v) jeans are acceptable with no holes.

6. ***Flexibility:*** The worship pastor always tries to give adequate notice of schedule or set list changes. There are times when it is necessary to change keys or include a requested song from the Lead Pastor, so please be willing to work with the worship leader when that situation arises.
