DivorceCare is a tool that can be offered to your church family members that may be struggling with divorce or separation. It is a Bible-based 13-week program designed to help those who are separated or divorced deal with life challenges that come with their situations. The weekly meetings cover topics like anger, depression, loneliness, financial survival, childcare, and forgiveness to name a few.
