January 2026 - Council Meeting Summary

Financial Status:

We are at the half-way point in our fiscal year. This is a good point to reflect on how we are doing financially. Overall, we are very close to our predictions. Total income is at 98.5% of budget, and expenses are similar, at 98.2%. Looking at dollars, over-all we are about \$4,000 ahead of plan. We did receive a relatively large estate, which helped our lagging church offerings. Offerings are still about \$10,000 lower than anticipated, and also \$35,000 lower when compared to a year ago. This is still a concern.

Work has starting on pulling together our next fiscal year Ministry Funding Plan, with a preliminary review planned for the April Voters Meeting.

Council Elections:

A nominating committee has been approved by council, and will start work on identifying candidates to fill upcoming vacant Council positions. Congregation President, Spiritual Life, and ECC chairmen are the positions our Constitution requires election at this year's April Voters Meeting.

Projects:

Two projects are in final estimating phase or at the board / council approval process. The school bathroom remodeling project is finalizing costs, then a funding plan can be developed. An update will be provided at the January voters meeting. The technology team has finalized estimates for a new combined school and ECC paging/intercom system which will greatly enhance safety. An overall funding plan has been proposed. Next steps are getting ECC board approval. School Board has already approved the project. Once council approves, these two projects are targeting voters' approval at a February Special Voters Meeting. Both projects are slated for a summer 2026 installation.
