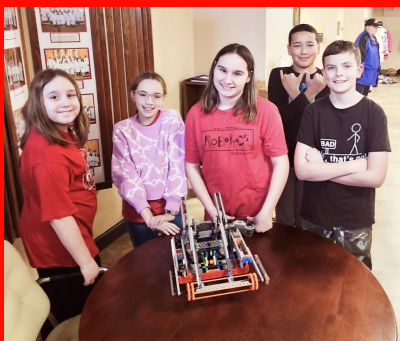
Kindergarten Open House
