2023-2024 Tuition Rates: The LES Board approved the 2023-2024 school year tuition to be \$1,300 for members (\$1,150 each additional student) and \$3,750 for non-members (\$3,250 for each additional student). The updated tuition rates will help support rising costs related to staffing, cost of books and materials, and technology/facility upgrades. The Lord continues to bless St. Paul Ministries so that we can continue to keep our tuition rates among the lowest in our area.
