Join Us for Worship! Sunday services are at 8am & 10:30am with Sunday School and Bible Class in between. Monday service is at 6pm. All are welcome! *“I rejoiced with those who said to me, ‘Let us go to the house of the LORD.’” (Psalm 122:1)*

New Starting Point Class Starts 1/11: Whether you’re brand new to the Bible, exploring Christianity for the first time, or simply looking for a solid refresher, Starting Point is the perfect place to begin. This 8-week course offers a welcoming, no-pressure environment to ask questions, discover what the Bible says, and learn the core truths of the Christian faith. We’ll cover topics like:

- Who is God?
- Why do we need a Savior?
- What is grace?
- How does faith grow?
- Why the Bible can be trusted

Classes begin Sunday, January 11th, at 9:15 in the School Learning Center and run weekly for 8 sessions. Each meeting lasts about an hour and includes discussion, guided study, and practical application. 2026-2027 Enrollment: Returning families should have received an email from noreply@infosnap.com with enrollment instructions for the 2026-2027 school year. *Please answer NO to signing up for sports and other extracurricular activities at this time.* Any families wanting to enroll new students, not currently enrolled at St. Paul, for the 2026-2027 school year must first fill out an [APPLICATION](#) that will be reviewed at the monthly School Board meeting. Please complete the enrollment process **prior to February 9** so that we know how many open seats there are for new families wanting to enroll at St. Paul. Please contact Mr. Ivan if you need assistance with enrolling for the 2026-2027 school year.

Tuition Rates: The LES Board approved the 2026-2027 school year tuition to be \$1,800 for members and \$5,200 for nonmembers. These rates can be found on our [WEBSITE](#). The updated tuition rates will help support rising costs related to staffing, cost of books and materials, inflation, and technology/facility upgrades. The actual cost to educate each child at St. Paul is approximately \$10,000. The Lord continues to richly bless St. Paul Ministries so that we can help keep our tuition rates among the lowest in our area. WPCP Reapplication Reminder for 2026-2027: As we look ahead to the 2026-2027 school year, the Wisconsin Parental Choice Program (WPCP) is moving to a monthly application system. While this provides flexibility, seats are filled as applications are verified each month. Because our school has a limited number of Choice seats available, returning families are encouraged to apply as early as possible. **IMPORTANT - *Returning families are NOT guaranteed a spot. Seats may be filled by families who apply in an application before you.***
