Worship Services at St. Paul Lutheran Church: Please join us for worship! Services are Sunday mornings at 8:00, 9:15, and 10:30. Monday evenings are at 6:00pm. Chapel Tomorrow: Our school will come together for a socially distanced chapel service tomorrow morning at 8:10. Since we will not be hosting the Veterans Day ceremony at school this year, we have decided to **dismiss students at 12:30PM on November 12** so that we can serve hot lunch to our students before they leave.
