Teacher News: Mrs. Dina Dietzler, our 3rd grade teacher, informed us that she will resign at the end of this school year. Mrs. Dietzler will be working as a writer for our new Bible curriculum that is currently being developed for our early childhood centers, grade schools, and high schools. The LES Board will be meeting soon to discuss replacing this position for the 2026-2027 school year. We plan to issue a divine call for this position on October 28.

Please use Harris Street for drive through and drop off purposes only. There will be no parking available on Harris Street near our school building. This means that you will pull up to the entrance and let your child out of your car to enter the building. **The traffic flow pattern will go eastward along Harris Street, so please utilize Appleton Street for your entrance to Harris Street.** Please be as timely as possible when dropping off your child. If you do need to come into the building to drop off your child, utilize the 2 hour parking on the east side of Durkee Street or the 2 hour parking on Harris Street to the east of our campus. ****Pick Up 3:10-3:45PM****

Please use Harris Street for drive through and pick up purposes only. There will be no parking available on Harris Street near our school building. This means that you will pull up along Harris Street and faculty and staff will help bring the children to you for pick up. **The traffic flow pattern will go eastward along Harris Street, so please utilize Appleton Street for your entrance to Harris Street.** Please be as timely as possible when picking up your child. It would be best if you could stagger your pick up throughout the pick up time to alleviate traffic congestion. This means that not everyone needs to pick up at 3:10PM. We have extended the pick up time so that we have extra time for children to be picked up from school. If you do need to come into the building to pick off your child, utilize the 2 hour parking on the east side of Durkee Street or the 2 hour parking on Harris Street to the east of our campus.
