Police Lights of Christmas – Snack Drive: St. Paul is teaming up with Police Lights of Christmas to collect **snack type** nonperishable items. These snacks will be included along with other donated items to help fill 1,000 backpacks. The backpacks will be given to local police departments throughout northeast Wisconsin. Police officers will carry these backpacks in their cars while on patrol to hand out to those in need within their communities. Donations will be accepted starting on October 17th through November 15th. A tote will be located at the Harris Street entrance of the school and another at the ECC. Items to be donated are individually wrapped nonperishable snacks (granola bars, fruit snacks, small bags of chips, small bags of crackers, nuts, cookies, raisins, etc). Monetary donations can also be dropped off in the school office or ECC office. Because St. Paul is collecting donations, Police Lights of Christmas will be purchasing gift cards through our Scrip program that benefits the St. Paul Tuition Assistance Fund. Police Lights will be giving the gift cards to Law Enforcement agencies throughout Northeast Wisconsin to hand out to those in need.
