August 2022 Council Meeting Summary 6:30 pm – October 18, 2022

Financial: We fell a bit behind our year-to-date budget in September due to several reasons: ECC had classroom closures due to COVID, the office project delayed start of pre-K class, and offerings are slightly behind budget.

Staffing: The ECC still has several staffing needs despite some recent hirings, and the School is still seeking a part-time lunch assistant.

North School Entrance Drop Off Area Expansion: Concrete has been poured to expand this area, and the old garage driveway was removed. Back-filling area with dirt is next.

Bell Project: The down payment has been made. Look for information on the fund drive to help fund this project to get all three of our bells in the bell tower tolling again (currently only one works).

Stock Donation: St. Paul has received notification of an upcoming stock gift designated for Debt Retirement, with the donor requesting a matching challenge. Watch for details on this great opportunity to start reducing our bank loan principal.
