Worship Services at St. Paul Lutheran Church: Please join us for worship! Services are Sunday mornings at 8:00 and 10:30. Monday evenings are at 6:00pm. Due to the governor's mask mandate, face coverings are required at all services, with the exception of those with medical reasons preventing them from wearing one. <u>Police Lights of Christmas:</u> St. Paul Lutheran Ministries is once again partnering with Q90 FM and our local police, fire, and rescue departments to help those in need over this Christmas season. There are many individuals right here in our



neighborhood that are homeless or are having trouble making ends meet that we'd like to help, but how can we find them? No one knows this better than our emergency services departments. We are teaming up with them so they may give out food, clothing, and other necessities to these people when they need it most. Last year, over 750 backpacks filled with necessities were prepared for hand out, as well as \$75,000 worth of gift cards. St. Paul Lutheran Church, School, and ECC will be a drop off location this year. We will be collecting men's deodorants, body washes, and individually packaged snacks (oatmeal, fruit snacks, chips, etc.) in bins located in the church basement, ECC lobby, and near the Harris Street entrance of the school beginning

Sunday, 10/25. The school drop off tote will be located just outside the doors on Harris Street, and available to both school families and the public to drop off items from 8am – 3pm. Monetary donations may be given through Community First Credit Union, or can be dropped off in the school office (cash or checks made payable to 'Lights of Christmas'). Donations will be accepted now through November 23<sup>rd</sup>.
