<u>Final Set of Science Curriculum Needed:</u> St. Paul recently adopted a new curriculum for Science instruction for our entire school K-8. We were able to purchase 2 out of 3 sets toward the implementation of this new curriculum by utilizing budgeted funds. We are currently acquiring donations to purchase the remaining science set so that we can fully implement our new curriculum. The cost for the remaining set is \$11,590. *There is still about \$5,000 needed to purchase this set.* We thank those who have already donated toward this curriculum!

This new curriculum has revolutionized the way our teachers instruct in our classrooms. Over time, this new program will help our students be ready for high school and beyond with this new hands on/inquiry based learning taking place within our classrooms.

Now through Christmas, we would like to raise the additional funds required to purchase the final set for our Science curriculum. We will be working with our Scrip program to raise the remaining funds.
