**On Monday, Dec 12,** we will prepare the cookie tins for our shut-in members. We start between 8:30 – 8:45 am in the **church basement.**

Cookies are ready for pick-up on the **school stage** by 11:00 on Monday. If you arrive before 1:30, school kitchen staff normally will still be there to open the gym door; however, if it is later, please go to the church office. Try to have the cookies delivered within the week.

Delivery drivers for the cookies are always needed. Last year, each person visited about two to four people. Delivery people will be given a preliminary list of their deliveries about a week in advance to allow time to contact Barb to request any changes. A final list will be placed with the tins for pick-up. Because of flu bugs and some lingering COVID, please call ahead so the shut-in is aware you are coming and/or to make sure the nursing home is open for visitors. If the shut-in is in a facility that is shut down, ask if the cookies can be left at the reception desk. If you are ever unable to deliver a cookie tin, keep them for yourself or share with a relative or friend.
