Council Meeting Summary November 15, 2022

Financial: Year-to-Date expenses have exceeded income by \$40,000 of what was budgeted. Church offerings are lower than budget by 4%, School is operating near budget, and the ECC income and expenditures are both below planned amounts.

Bank Loan: We have received several generous gifts (totaling nearly \$70,000) that donors requested be used to reduce our bank loan principal currently just above \$275,000. We have also received notification of an upcoming stock gift valued above \$20,000 also designated for Debt Retirement, with the donor requesting a matching challenge. With our Lord's blessing, these gifts and a successful match challenge, our loan principal could be reduced to nearly one-half of the original loan amount by year-end! What a blessing.

Bell Project: This project will restore bell operation of our three bells in the bell tower (two bells are no longer operational). We will be upgrading to electro-mechanical clappers (bells will no longer swing, reducing loading to the bell support structure. This project is nearly fully funded by gifts already received.

Technology Upgrade: A team has been working on what is needed to update/upgrade our current technology/sound system for church, radio broadcasting, and our Facebook live stream of our services. The project will address some outdated technology components, significantly improve the video and sound quality of our digital media, as well as bring us into compliance with portable microphone frequency regulations. A proposal will be presented at the next Voters Meeting (January 2023).
