<u>Christmas Food Pantry Collection:</u> We are collecting food for the Apple Valley Food pantry as our Christmas gifts to those in need. We want to show our thanks to our Creator for what he has given us by helping those who have not been given as much. Please have your child's gift(s) to their classrooms (located near the Harris Street entrance) by Tuesday, December 20<sup>th</sup>. The following list from the pantry will indicate what your child's class is collecting:

K: Boxed macaroni and cheese and canned pasta (ravioli's etc.)

- 1: Boxed meals (hamburger, chicken or tuna helpers) and canned fruit cocktail
- 2: Cookies and small plastic jars of applesauce (24 oz. size)
- 3: Peanut butter and jelly/jam and canned pears
- 4: Condensed tomato and chicken noodle soups, assorted crackers (Ritz, Triscuit and flavored types)
- 5: Cereal, preferably the healthier ones (plain and honey oat, corn flakes, rice, Chex type, Special K, Total, etc.)
- 6: Spaghetti noodles and pasta sauces and canned mandarin oranges
- 7: Packaged rice, noodle and potato sides
- 8: Canned meats (chicken and tuna) and canned diced tomatoes and tomato sauce

ECC: Cereal snack bars and pork n beans/baked beans
