- 3: Fruit snacks & boxed meals (hamburger, chicken or tuna helpers, rice/noodle side dishes, etc.)
- 4: Soups & crackers (any types of soup, saltines, Ritz, and cheesy crackers are very popular)
- 5: Canned pasta & vegetables (ravioli, spaghettio's, etc. and green beans, corn, mixed veggies, etc.)
- 6: Hygiene & home cleaning products (deodorants, lotions, body wash, shampoos and conditioners, men's 2-in-1 products, toilet bowl cleaners and kitchen and bathroom cleaners)
- 7: Cleaners & Paper Products (toilet bowl, kitchen/bath cleaner, toilet paper, paper towels, napkins and Kleenex)
- 8: Canned meats & Pork n Beans (canned chicken, tuna, Spam, etc)
- ECC: Baby items (diapers, wipes, shampoo, lotion, formula)
