January 2025 Voters Meeting Summary

3rd Grade Teacher Call: Voters reviewed a call list of 5 names, and voted to call Miss Lydia Drake to fill our upcoming vacancy. Miss Drake is a recent graduate of Wisconsin Lutheran College, and is currently serving as a paraprofessional at Immanuel in Greenville. Following protocols, this call is a 1-year provisional call, as she needs to complete WELS teacher certification. Keep Lydia in your prayers as she considers our call to serve at St. Paul.

Communion Assistants: Voters unanimously called additional communion assistants to help our Pastors in efficiently delivering the Lord's Supper in our church services. In addition to the current communion assistants, you will see the following men helping in upcoming services: Jason Kelley, Matthew Ivan, Michael Schulz, Jake Leyrer and Dave Buss. We thank these individuals for assisting our pastors during services.

School Bathroom Remodeling: Voters learned that cost estimates are being finalized. Next steps are that Trustees and Council will be developing a funding plan, and this project will be presented at a Special Voters Meeting to the congregation in February. At that meeting, expect project scope details, rationale and options, along with funding plans to be presented and discussed for action by the Voters Assembly.

Fiscal Stewardship: As previously reported, at the half-way point of our fiscal year, we are very near budget projections! Our overall income is slightly above our expenses, and all pillars of our ministries are operating close to budget projections. Slightly concerning is a continuing trend of reduced church offerings. Currently we are about \$10,000 below our offering projections.
