Mar 28/29... Scorn for Shame

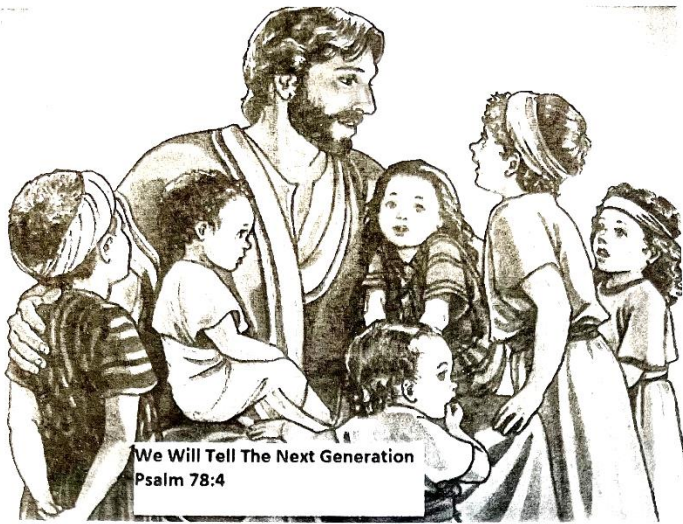




St. Paul Lutheran ECC in Appleton is hiring!
