
February 2021 Voters Meeting Summary

Projects: Voters approved proceeding with the ECC Basement and the School Classroom project at estimated amount of \$312,719. The project on the School Basement was tabled. We have available funding to support these two projects currently. Decision was made to use special funds from insurance settlement (\$24k), ECC Basement special funds (\$82k), and recent gifts (\$26k), and borrow the remainder to give greater flexibility to our budget due to COVID. This keeps a significant balance in our General Operating Fund Buffer. Expected completion for both projects is before school opens in August.

Facilities Coordinator: Voters approved the promotion of our custodian to Facilities Coordinator, a full-time salaried position, with added responsibilities of coordination of all facilities work, including volunteers.

School WELSSA Accreditation: Work will start on the Self-Study portion soon. Principal Kelley is looking for congregational volunteers to participate / help complete the self-study sections. Typically, small groups will meet 2 to 3 times to review information complete their section of the self-study. Contact Jason Kelley if interested and willing to help in this effort.
