THE RESURRECTION CANDLE

CHOIR Abide With Me – CW 588 v. 7

This service commemorates the suffering and death of Christ and is based on the ancient Tenebrae. Dating from the 8th Century, Tenebrae was originally celebrated on Wednesday, Thursday, and Friday of Holy Week. The darkness represents the darkness that fell over the earth as the Son of God was crucified. The candles symbolize Christ, the Light of the World. With each meditation the candles are progressively extinguished, portraying the fading Light of the world as Christ is leaving it. Yet one last vigil candle remains to indicate that death only seems triumphant over Christ, and points to his coming resurrection. May we see in this ancient symbolism our suffering Savior, and in him, our victorious faith, given to each of us by the grace of a loving God who loved us even to death, the death on Calvary's cross!
