Congregation Voters Meeting Summary **April 26, 2022 @6:30 pm**

Financial Update: We are complete with the third quarter of our fiscal year. Currently income is exceeding expenses by \$5,307, with no use of our operating buffer fund. We are essentially at budget predictions at this point in the year. In summary, School is operating near budget, the ECC is doing well financially, with church offerings down about 4% compared to budget plan.

2022-2023 Fiscal Budget: Council has been working on developing the budget for our next fiscal year. A preliminary budget was presented, currently projecting a \$14,343 deficit (utilizing those funds from our operating buffer fund). This proposed budget has the ECC operating at net neutral. It also shows no increase for general offering income. Additional updates and refinements are ongoing, as things like enrollment numbers, and school choice details are finalized. Approval of the final budget will take place in our June Voters meeting.

Staffing: Staffing needs in our ECC remain, with several positions open. Special thanks to our current staff who are covering those needs through extra hours and overtime. Mr. Guy Gast has returned our call to teach 6th Grade, so look for a Special Voters Call Meeting soon to fill that vacancy at our school.

Church Leadership: Voters approved Jake Holm as the new ECC Chairman and Perry Abitz to continue as Congregation President for his second term. A nominating committee is working to fill the open Board of Spiritual Life Chairman position.

Facilities: Work on final design and costs for creating office space in the ECC for Pastor Shrum, who will arrive here in June! Voters will need to approve the project and funding once design and costs are finalized. It is hoped that construction can be completed this summer.
