## May 2022 Council Meeting Summary

6:30 pm – May 17, 2022

**Financial:** With the last 2 months remaining in our fiscal year, total expenses are exceeding our income and offerings by \$11,728 (in the red). With solid offerings in May and June, and the last school choice payment coming in May, we hope to get back up to “even” for the entire fiscal year (end of June).

**Staffing:** We have recently called Mr. Matthew Ivan for the 6<sup>th</sup> Grade Teaching vacancy, and are prayerfully awaiting his response. Staffing needs (both full and part-time) in our ECC remain to reach planned staffing levels.

**June Voters Meeting:** The next voters meeting will be on Father's Day - June 19 following the late service (meeting starting around 10:30 am) in the church basement. Significant agenda items will be our next fiscal year budget presentation and approval, as well as project funding approval for adding an office in the ECC for Pastor Shrum, with work tentatively planned to start in June.
