In-Person Worship Services - Update: Beginning June 14th, we will be going to **2 services on Sundays** (8 & 9:30) and one on Monday (6pm). You do not need to sign up to attend. *Our members CAN and are welcome to worship with us every week!* Current worship attendance trends should allow us to keep attendance numbers below the recommended 25% of capacity. We will continue to practice social distancing, utilizing every other pew, keeping at least 6' from others, and encouraging visiting outside rather than in the narthex. Communion will be given on the first and third Sundays of the month, as in the past. Our 8am services will continue to be on facebook live and on WNAM 1280 AM.

A message from the Apple Valley Food Pantry: Our next pantry collection date is **Sunday, June 14, 2020**. Feel free to drop donations off in the St. Paul Church basement beginning 5/31. If you are not comfortable worshipping in-person, donations can be taken directly to the pantry at St. Matthew's (129 S. Mason Street in Appleton). Items needed by the food pantry are: **Cereal (on average between 150-175 boxes are needed per month), cookies, crackers, boxed potatoes, canned fruits, macaroni and cheese, hamburger helpers, toilet paper and paper towel, pancake mix and syrup, tomato and chicken soups, all canned meats, peanut butter, and healthy snacks.**

Thank you for the amazing gifts for the pantry that were received over the past couple of months! We have been overwhelmed by your generosity to the response of our needs to assist those using our pantry. Your love and compassion to help us during this difficult time have eased our concerns for the time being because the need is always going to be there to assist others who need it the most.
