June 2022 Special Voters Meeting Summary 10:30 pm – June 19, 2022

Financial: With only June remaining in our current fiscal year, projections are we will finish in the black, not using any General Operating Buffer Fund money. Voters approved the 2022-23 fiscal year budget with an income short-fall of \$28,174 (with that amount committed from the General Operating Buffer Fund).

ECC Office Modifications: Voters approved spending up to \$65,000 to modify the office area in the ECC to provide dedicated offices for Pastor Justin Shrum, and our ECC Assistant Director. Funding will come from our current Line of Credit, with the reminder funded from the General Operating Buffer Fund (roughly \$10,000). Long lead items will be ordered shortly, and work is anticipated to start later this summer.

Spiritual Life Board Chairman: Voters elected Dan Vogel to fill this open position.
