WELS Apple Valley Food Pantry News: The July 2025 collection for the pantry will be Sunday, July 6th. The following is a list of items currently in need of: Helper meals, adult cereals, canned fruit cocktail, mandarins, peaches, pears, canned pasta, plain rice in 14 oz. boxes, pasta sauce, canned chicken, tuna and salmon, canned tomato soup, canned cream of mushroom and chicken soups, pork n beans/baked beans, canned tomato products (sauce, diced and stewed), canned chilis and stews, jams, peanut butter and laundry soap (40 loads or less). We have entered the slow months for pantry collections; thank you for your continued support which is greatly needed.

Facility Improvement Project Update: Since their approval at the 4/29/25 Voter's Meeting, Special Funds have been set up for congregation members to donate directly to the following four projects. Status updates are as follows:

- Project 1 - Replace Interior School Doors:
Cost \$38,918; \$15,144 Remaining
- Project 2 - Replace Kindergarten Room Flooring:
Cost \$8,964; \$8,824 Remaining
- Project 3 - Repave Parking Lot:
Cost \$83,500; \$78,024 Remaining
- Project 4 - ECC Room Dividers:
Cost \$13,000; \$6,985 Remaining

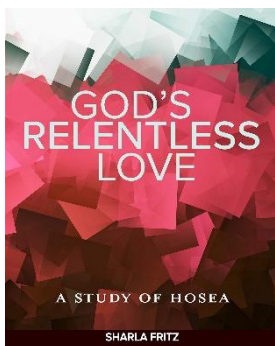
