Opportunity to Serve God's Kingdom: St. Paul Lutheran Church (N926 Dale Ave. in Dale, WI) and St. Peter's Ev. Lutheran Church (8630 County Road MM, Larsen, WI – don't use Apple GPS as we are really located on the edge of Winchester Township) are looking for motivated Christians who might be willing to teach Sunday School. For the last two years the congregations have been blessed by young people from other WELS churches willing to teach classes during the church services. Typically, the Sunday school class might last for about 35 minutes. The format is the same at both churches. Parents bring their children to the scheduled service (8 a.m. at St. Paul and 10 a.m. at St. Peter's) and the family sits together for the first part of the service. Before the sermon hymn the children assemble for a devotion with the pastor in church and after the devotion they go with their teacher to their classrooms. The lessons and activities are led by the teachers during the service. The parents meet their children following the service.

Would you know of any persons (any age), who might be willing to help with the Sunday school programs at these two churches? It would be possible for different people to serve the two time slots. The congregations have been paying \$20 per Sunday to defray costs of transportation (cost adjustment can
