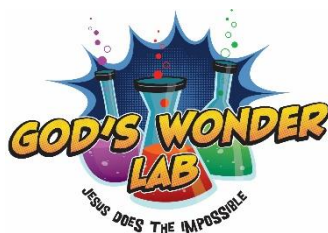

June 2021 Special Voters Meeting Summary

2021 – 2022 Budget: Voters approved the budget for 2021-2022, approving up to \$47,249 transfer from our General Operating Buffer Fund to maintain a balanced budget.

1st Grade Teaching Vacancy: Voters unanimously extended a one-year call to teach 1st Grade for the 2021-2022 school year to retired 1st Grade teacher Mrs. Nancy Zander.

Playground Mulch: Voters approved replacing the wood chip mulch on the large School/ECC playground with “Jelly Bean Rubber Mulch”. Jelly Bean Rubber Mulch material will cost \$19,932 with total spending up to \$25,000 from the MLF Funds being approved. The additional amount will cover mulch removal, and new base/liner. This project has a break-even 7 year payback, and will provide a safer playground base than the current wood chip mulch that degrades and compacts. The project may be able to be completed in mid-to-late August before school starts, depending on material delivery timing. Volunteers will be needed to remove existing wood mulch and place the new “Jelly Bean Rubber Mulch”.
